





Friday, February 2nd 6pm-8pm- Jr. High Weigh-Ins @ Rise Complex ALL 6th-7th-8th PARTICIPANTS & 9t GRADE BOYS MUST WEIGH-IN FRIDAY FOR THIS EVENT!

Wrestlers must weigh-in wearing a singlet or pair of shorts & shirt.

Wrestlers who fail to make the weight they are registered for will a) be scratched from the tournament OR b) pay a \$20 re-bracketing fee.

Event Admission for spectators, parents, and fans will be sold during weigh-ins.

Entry Fee: \$40 with current valid USA Membership

\$48 for non-members. \$50/58 LATE REGISTRATION

<u>Payment</u> for individual registrations <u>must be made online</u> at the time of registration.

TEAMS wanting to pay by school check must contact Event Coordinator AT THE TIME OF REGISTRATION.

Online payment is strongly preferred, but school checks are an available option by prior arrangement.

\$5 discount per entry for teams/clubs registering 10 or more wrestlers (must be on the same registration)

ALL current USA memberships, INCLUDING Limited Folkstyle memberships (\$20) are valid for this event. *Memberships will be valid through August 31, 2024.* Memberships may be purchased at www.usawmembership.com

You <u>must</u> wrestle your grade and may not "wrestle up" in either weight OR age nor wrestle in two grades/weight classes. No wrestler may compete in a Jr. High Division more than once in their career.

COACHES AND SPECTATOR INFORMATION

Coaches Wristbands/Floor Pass: *FREE* TO *USA WRESTLING LEADERS*. MUST SHOW MEMBERSHIP AT CHECK-IN. To <u>Coach at this event you must have</u> a valid USA Leaders Membership. These must be completed in advance and can be obtained through

Spectator Admission: \$15 \$5 for students. Under 5 Free

Parking: \$5 per vehicle.

No outside food or coolers are allowed in the complex. Bags will be searched prior to entry into the arena. Full concessions will be available on site.

ELEMENTARY DIVISION INFORMATION

Team competition for the Elementary Division is based on USAW Clubs, not schools. All wrestlers used in team scoring must be registered under the correct team name. Clubs must be chartered for 23-24 to be eligible for the team championships. Team Charters can be completed online at www.usawmembership.com. Awards will be presented to the top two elementary division teams at the

Awards will be presented to the top two elementary division teams at the conclusion of the event .Grades Pre-k -5 wrestle Folkstyle, grouping entrants by grade and weight. USA Times will be used for Elementary Divisions

JR. HIGH DIVISION INFORMATION

Team competition for Jr. High division will be *based on schools*. All wrestlers used in team scoring must be registered under the correct team name. Bouts are 2-1-1 Championship Bracket, 1-1-1 Consolation.



Team competition for Jr. High division will be *based on schools*. All wrestlers used in team scoring must be registered under the correct team name and approved before competition begins. Bouts are 2-1-1 Championship Bracket, 1-1-1 Consolation.

A wrestler's *real school* (for which the wrestled in the regular season) is the wrestler's team, Any school(s) found to be combining athletes for team scoring purposes without prior approval from event directors will be disqualified from team competition. If athletes are not affiliated with a school team during the regular season they cannot be affiliated with a school team for the purpose of team scoring. Awards will be presented to the top two teams in the Jr. High Division at the conclusion of the tournament.

OTHER INFORMATION

Only two coaches in a corner (wristbands required). Folkstyle mat rules, double elimination system, no rematches.

Headgear required. Singlets or two piece uniforms suggested, but not required. **There is no seeding**. Wrestlers from the same school/area will be separated as best we can. The winner and his/her coach is responsible for checking bout sheet and signing it before leaving the mat area.

QUALIFYING INFORMATION

Wrestlers participating in this event are qualified to participate in the following:

NC Schoolboy Dual Team (Birth Years 2010-11)- Top 3 wrestlers of schoolboy age in each weight class will be *eligible* to participate on the NC Schoolboy Dual Team.

USA National Folkstyle Championships March 31st

Cedar Falls, IA– Any wrestler participating in the NC State Championships is eligible to participate in the USA National Folkstyle Championships.

NC TOP 50- This event is the FIRST event in the NC TOP 50 Series. Top 50 point earners will receive custom Top 50 T-Shirts and recognition. This is also the 1st leg of the NC Triple Crown Award
