Football Saskatchewan is accepting applicants for the **Head Coach and Assistant Coaches for the 2020 Senior Women's Team Saskatchewan that will be competing in a National Championship.**

The head coach position will lead our Saskatchewan team at the National Championships. The Football Canada Senior Women's National Championship's primary objective is to, "bring together women's provincial tackle football teams from across Canada and provide players the opportunity to participate in a National Championship while developing their skills." The 2020 Sr. Women's National Championship will be from July 30 to August 8, 2020 in Sherwood Park, AB.

Coaches applying for this position must commit for a term of **one year**. The Head Coach position requires a significant time commitment to scout and identify players, as well as coach the Senior Women's Team Sask at the 2020 National Championship. In addition, the Head Coach, with assistance from the Football Saskatchewan staff, is responsible for selecting all assistant coaches.

Football Saskatchewan will forward the information to the successful Head Coach. The Head Coach will consider these applications, but is not obligated to select the Team Saskatchewan staff from those submissions.

Professional Development	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Level 2 or 3 NCCP certification OR Intro to Comp or Comp Dev. in training • Additional training/development courses (Incl. Safe Contact & Making Ethical Decision) • First Aid and/or Sport Injury training
Knowledge of Program	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Proven knowledge of Football Saskatchewan programs and services • Ability to work towards the objectives of Football Saskatchewan's Sr. Women's National Championship Program • Leadership skills, critical thinker, organized, planner, follow direction, respectful. • Proven appreciation for and awareness of the unique problems that may occur in the selection and operation of a Provincial Team Program

EXPECTATIONS:

- Ability to commit the time necessary to make Team Saskatchewan successful
- Identify potential Team Saskatchewan players
- Evaluate at two or more provincial team camps
- Evaluate (as requested) in the Football Saskatchewan selection camps
- Participate (as requested) in the Football Saskatchewan Coaches Clinic
- Work with mentor coaches and/or advisors to improve coaching approaches specific to competition
- Submit to a criminal record check
