The player's guardian must submit the following documentation in order for a player to be considered for a scholarship:

1. Verification of participation in one of the following financial assistance programs.
 - La Plata County Department of Human Services: Women, Infants, and Children Program
 - Food Stamps Program
 - 9 - R Free and Reduced Meal Program
 - Medicaid or CHP+
 - Disabilities with verification
2. Letter of explanation, including:
 - Financial need of scholarship
 - Special personal circumstances relating to the scholarship request
 - Intention of volunteer commitment
 - Copy of applicant player's most recent academic report card
3. Parents will be asked to provide a minimum of 25 hours of volunteer time per scholarship and email a list of completed hours each month to the DAYHA board contact. All hours must be completed by March 1st.
4. Deadline for applications is September 30, 2018 and player/participant must be already registered.

All scholarship awards will be applied as credit to the DAYHA account and not in cash. Awards are at the full discretion of the DAYHA Administrative Board and DAYHA Scholarship Committee. Scholarship awards are limited to funds available.

You will be notified when the DAYHA scholarship committee has made a decision based on the information provided.
