Roster Submission & Adult Credential Pickup

Team Check-In & Rosters

- Rosters must be submitted at the Team Check-In Desk before your first match
- Only 1 coach per team may enter facility initially to:
 - Submit roster
 - Pick up coach wristbands
- A maximum of 3 rostered adults per team will receive wristbands

Entry & Credentials

- Wristbanded coaches do **not** need a clear bag for entry (Podium)
- Players **do not need wristbands** if arriving in uniform
- Security will direct players and coaches to the **right-side front entrance doors**

U.S. Teams:

- Must provide a **printed official SportsEngine roster** OR
- Another **USAV-verified roster approved by the ERVA Office** prior to the event

Canadian Teams:

- Must provide appropriate **USAV-approved documentation** (please ensure compliance prior to arrival)

Referee & Scorekeeping Requirements

- Teams will be responsible for **scorekeeping and refereeing** as assigned.
 - R1, R2 Score Table & Line Judges

General Facility Guidelines

- **Court Rules**
 - **No gum** on the courts.
 - **Water only** is allowed on the playing surface, including the scorer's table.
 - Sports drinks are **not permitted** (they are sticky when spilled).
 - **No pets** allowed in the facility.
 - Please **supervise all children** at all times.
- **The Podium**
 - **Outside Food & Drink Policy:**
 - **No outside food is permitted inside The Podium. (medical exceptions apply)**
 - Bottled water WILL be allowed into The Podium. **ONLY** non-flavored water will be allowed in the court area.
 - **Team Areas**
 - There will be designated areas for teams to be able to leave their gear when they are not playing , if desired. **We do not recommend leaving personal belongings unattended.**
 - If players decide to keep their gear with them please make sure you are allowing enough space in the bleachers for spectators.
 - **Parking**

 - **PAYING FOR PARKING**
 - All parking lots require payment. Please follow the posted instructions to pay for lots without an attendant on site. There are no in-out privileges for vehicles during an event. Parking rates may vary per lot.

- Team Areas

- Food is allowed in the facility.
