RENO SET TO DEFEND HOME PITCH AGAINST LA GALAXY II

RENO, Nev. – After a road loss in San Antonio, Reno 1868 FC returns home to Greater Nevada Field this weekend to welcome LA Galaxy II to Northern Nevada. Reno leads the all-time series with LA 4-0-0, and has yet to lose a home match this season.

"The guys after a loss are practicing a bit testy, a little more physical," said head coach Ian Russell. "They're not sulking, they're not pouting, they're ready to go."

In San Antonio, Reno took a 2-1 lead into halftime thanks to goals from forwards Corey Herzog and Cade Cowell. The first goal, off Herzog's right foot, came just seven minutes into the match and raised his season total to six. In the 16th minute, fifteen-year-old Cowell pounced on an errant pass and fired the ball into the net for his first career USL Championship goal. The match was Cowell's first start with the team.

"We had a good chance to go up three, Raul Mendiola hit the crossbar," said Russell. "We had a good first half and felt good going into the second half."

LA is coming off of a 3-0 road loss to El Paso. The loss is their second straight scoreless match, and was their first defeat since a 3-0 loss to Fresno on May 12. The Galaxy II had tied their previous four matches.

On the season, Reno is 3-0-3 in the friendly confines of Greater Nevada field, and LA is 1-2-2 on the road. LA comes into Reno averaging fewer goals and shots per match than 1868 FC, and sports a -9 goal differential to Reno's +7.

"Typically they are a mix of some younger players along with the first team players that are coming down," said Russell. "Should be a good team coming."

Only two points separate the two teams in the USL Championship's Western Conference, as Los Angeles sits in the 11 spot with 18 points. Reno sits in eighth with 20 points on the season.

Saturday's action gets underway at 7:15 p.m. PT, with gates opening at 6:15 p.m. PT. The first 1,000 fans in attendance will receive an 1868 FC soccer ball, and the first fireworks show of the season will start after the match. Tickets are still available at reno1868fc.com or the Greater Nevada Field ticket office.



#2 EMRAH KLIMENTA (D)



HEIGHT: 5'11" WEIGHT: 170 LBS DOB: 10/3/97 Klimenta, 28, signed with Reno 1868 FC early into the 2019 season. The defender joins Reno after a lengthy career with Sacramento Republic FC. Klimenta became Republic FC's all-time leader in minutes, appearances, and starts for the club. The defender had 102 total appearances, nine goals and five assists.

#3 BENJAMIN GALINDO CRUZ (D)



HEIGHT: 6'2" WEIGHT: 187 LBS DOB: 3/10/99 Galindo Cruz, 19, joins Reno on loan from Chivas de Guadalajara. The forward made four appearances for the Mexican club in the 2018-2019 season and two in the previous season. He is the son of Benajmin Galindo who made 65 appearances and scored 28 goals for the Mexico national football team.

#5 ZACH CARROLL (D)



HEIGHT: 6'4" WEIGHT: 185 LBS DOB: 3/16/94 Carroll, 24, returns to Reno 1868 FC after a standout 2018 season. The 6-foot-3 defender was the team captain for the 2018 season and had 30 appearances. He scored two goals and had two assists for the club. Carroll was named Reno's Defensive Player of the Year for 2018.

#6 THOMAS JANJIGIAN (D)



Janjigian, 24, returns for his third season with Reno 1868 FC. The 6-foot-4 defender made 20 appearances for the club in 2018 and four in 2017. He was called up to play for MLS affialiate San Jose Earthquakes in the 2017 U.S. Open Cup.

#8 WILL SEYMORE (M)

The midfielder made four starts and nine appearances for FC CIncinnati while recording one of the highest passing accuracies on the team (83 percent) and won half of his aerial duels. Before joining FC Cincinnati in 2017, Seymore played for Vancouver Whitecaps FC 2 for two years (2015-2017)

#9 DANNY MUSOVSKI (F)



HEKGAT: 6'0'' WEEGAH: 1390BBS DQB: 17/10/94 Musovski, 23, was drafted by the San Jose Earthquakes in the second round of the 2018 MLS SuperDraft and then loaned to Reno 1868 FC for the 2018 season. The forward had five goals, 11 clearances and five interceptions in 17 game appearances last season.

#10 LINDO MFEKA (M)



HEIGHT: 5'5" WEIGHT: 155 LBS DOB: 3/30/94 Mfeka, 24, a returning midfielder for Reno 1868 FC helped score four goals in the 2018 season. The South American native, added three assists while boasting an 85 percent pass success rate in his 24 starts.

#11 DUKE LACROIX (D)



HEIGHT: 5'9" WEIGHT: 154 LBS DOB: 10/14/93 Lacroix, 25, a returning defender for Reno 1868 FC helped score one goal and five assists with an 82 percent pass success rate in the 2018 season. He added to his 2018 campaign with 35 clearances, 7 blocks, and 40 interceptions in 28 games.

#12 MATT BERSANO (GK)



HEIGHT: 6'1" WEIGHT: 185 LBS DOB: 9/10/92 Bersano, 26, will spend time with Reno 1868 FC for the third season in a row. The Goalkeeper was signed to the San Jose Earthquakes in 2017 and spent back-to-back seasons with Reno. In 2017, he started 28 games and accumulated 2,520 minutes, making 73 saves and tallying nine clean sheets for Reno. In 2018, he made 11 starts for Reno and was selected to the USL Team of the Week in Week 30. He was named Reno 1868 FC's Goalkeeper of the Year in 2018.

#13 NATHAN AUNE (D)



HEIGHT: 6'4" WEIGHT: 185 LBS DOB: 10/27/96 Aune, 22, was drafted by the San Jose Earthquakes in the second round of the 2019 MLS SuperDraft. The defender was a four-year starter at Seattle Univeristy where he scored six goals and had one assist in his 80 appearances. His senior year he was named to the All-Western Athletic Conference First Team as well as the United Soccer Coaches All-West Region Second Team.

#14 ERIC CALVILLO (M)



HEIGHT: 5'7" WEIGHT: 138 LBS DOB: 9/10/92 Calvillo, 21, was signed to the San Jose Earthquakes for the 2018 season and spent time with both the San Jose Earthquakes and Reno 1868 FC in the 2018 season. He made 10 starts in 11 total appearances for Reno as well as two starts in three total appearances in MLS play. The midfielder scored one goal for Reno 1868 FC and was selected to the USL Team of the week during week 27 of the 2018 season.

#15 YOSIMAR HERNANDEZ (D)



HEIGHT: 5'9" WEIGHT: 150 LBS DOB: 09/14/97 Hernandez, 21, was signed to Reno at the beginning of the 2019 season. Hernandez was called up to the U.S U-15 National team in 2011. HEIGHT: 5'10" WEIGHT: 167 LBS DOB: 5/20/90 Richards, 28, a returning defender for Reno 1868 FC boasted 122 clearances, 16 blocks, and 73 interceptions in the 2018 season. He added to a stellar defensive season with four assists and a 73 percent pass success rate in 33 games.



HEIGHT: 5'9" WEIGHT: 170 LBS DOB: 05/24/1996 Apodaca, 22, was signed to Reno 1868 FC at the beginning of the 2019 season. The forward was selected 55th overall in the 2018 MLS Super-Draft by the Philadelphia Union. He later signed with the club's USL affiliate, Bethlehem Steel FC, where he spent the 2018 season. He had 17 appearances for the club, scored two goals and had two assists.

#18 JT MARCINKOWSKI (GK)



HEIGHT: 6'1:" WEIGHT: 182 DOB: 05/09/1997 Marcinkowski, 21, will spend time with Reno 1868 FC for the second season in a row. Signed to the San Jose Earthquakes as a Homegrown Player in 2017, the goalkeeper spent time with both the Earthquakes and Reno in 2018. Marcinkowski started five times for San Jose and 24 for Reno. Marcinkowski was selected to USL's Team of the Week in week two of the 2018 season and was named Reno 1868 FC's Rookie of the Year in 2018.

#20 MARKY HERNANDEZ (M)



HEIGHT: 5'5" WEIGHT:145 LBS DOB: 08/07/1996 Hernandez, 22, was signed to Reno 1868 FC at the beginning of the 2019 season. The midfielder spent two years at Golden West Junior College and then played his junior and senior years at Cal State Fullerton. In his two seasons with the Titans he appeared in 40 games, had four goals, and four assists.

#21 COREY HERTZOG (F)



HEIGHT: 6'0" WEIGHT: 172 LBS DOB: 8/01/90 Hertzog, 28, was signed to Reno 1868 FC in 2019. The forward formerly played for Saint Louis FC and boasts 45 goals and 12 assissts in the 120 career appearances of his USL career. In 2018, he recorded four goals and three assists in 26 appearances. He added to his career with 12 appearances in the MLS for the Vancouver Whitecaps where he recorded one goal and had one assist.

#22 SIAD HAJI (M)



HEIGHT: 5'8" WEIGHT: 150LBS DOB: 12/1/99 Haji, 19, was selected by the San Jose Earthquakes with the number 2 overall pick in the first round of the 2019 MLS SuperDraft. Haji was signed to the club as a Generation Adidas player. the midfielder spent his freshman year of college at New England College where he had nine goals in 14 games. He then spent the 2017 and 2018 seasons at Virginia Commonwealth University where he notched two goals and eight assists in 17 appearnces in 2017. The midfielder made 18 starts from 18 appearances scoring five goals and 10 assists in the 2018 season.

#23 SAM GLEADLE (M)



HEIGHT: 5'10" WEIGHT: 155 LBS DOB: 3/20/96 Gleadle, 22, returns to Reno 1868 FC after two non-USL appearances in the 2018 season. Before signing with Reno 1868 FC, Gleadle spent time with USL League 2 (formerly USL PDL) club Albuquerque Sol FC after graduating from the University of New Mexico, where he was four-year starter.

#24 GILBERT FUENTES (M)



HEIGHT: 5'6" WEIGHT: 146 LBS DOB: 2/21/02 Fuentes, 17, signed as a homegrown player in 2018 for the San Jose Earthquakes. The young midfielder made his MLS debut on October 21st against the Colorado Rapids, going in as a substitute in the 89th minute. During the 2018 season, Fuentes made four appearances for Reno 1868 FC.

Russell was drafted by the San Jose Earthquakes in 2000 and continued to play seven seasons in MLS. Six of those seasons came with the Earthquakes, where Russell helped the team win two MLS Cups in 2001 and 2003.
