Competitive Levels: Level 9 & Level 10 athletes may qualify to the 2024 Regional Championships.

Qualification: The 2024 Regional qualifying scores are:

Level 9: 34.00AA at the State meet OR by prequalifying* with a 35.00 AA scored at any USA Gymnastics sanctioned event during the current season. Athletes may qualify as IES with a 9.00 on the event at States OR by petitioning with a 9.2 on the event at any USA Gymnastics sanctioned event during the current season. *Prequalification to regionals includes registering and participating in the State meet to qualify.

Level 10: 34.00AA at the State meet OR by prequalifying with 35.00 AA scored at any USA Gymnastics sanctioned event during the current. Athletes may qualify as IES with a 9.00 on the event at States OR by petitioning with a 9.2 on the event at any USA Gymnastics sanctioned event during the current season. *Prequalification to regionals includes registering and participating in the State meet to qualify.

Registration: All registrations must be made through USAG Meet Reservations & MeetMaker.com. Registration fee is \$140/ athlete -online payment is required at the time of registration. Registration will close at 11:59pm on Monday, March 25, 2024. Registered athletes and coaches will receive a Region 7 t-shirt—please enter t-shirt sizes when registering in MeetMaker.

Meet Format: Modified Capitol Cup-1 Gym with 2 sets of identical equipment.

Music: All floor music must be downloaded to an iPad, iPod or MP3 player before the competition. **Online streaming or downloading of music will not be available.**

Awards: Individual event & All-Around awards will be presented to each age group at the conclusion of the competition. Senior Ceremonies will be conducted at the end of the sessions as necessary.

Competition Schedule: Sessions will be determined by level and age groups—there is NO team competition. Final session times will be emailed to addresses used to register athletes in MeetMaker as well as posted to region7usagym.com, meetmaker.com and centreelitegymnastics.com. Coaches Information: All coaches planning on coaching during the competition MUST be registered through USA Gymnastics Reservation. System for membership verification. Coaches must present their current USAG Professional Member card at sign in. Any coach not registered will be unable to coach until membership verification has been completed.
