Using your computer's browser:

- Follow instructions on-screen to register Participant(s) and add family and friends
 - Note: More than one sibling may be registered under the same family registration.

Using your Apple or Android phone or tablet:

- Go to Apple App Store or Google Play store and search for "PLEDGESTAR" to download the family app:
- On the Home Screen enter your event code: "tesoro" to locate your event.
- Click "Not registered for this Year's Event"
- Enter your name and email address then click "Submit"
- Follow the instructions on-screen to register Participant(s) and add family and friends
 - Note: More than one sibling may be registered under the same family registration

When you finish registration, the system will send email pledge requests to your family and friends, allowing them to make secure credit card donations online. You will get notified each time a pledge is made and you can track your pledge progress online.

Chain of Communication & Code of Conduct

If a player has a concern with <u>practices</u> and <u>games</u>, she should first address the issue with Coach Bella. This should be accomplished in a timely manner. Being able to communicate effectively with adults is part of becoming a successful young woman. If after meeting the coach, and the issue is still unresolved, then a parent meeting should be scheduled with the Coach. Any issues with the <u>lacrosse program</u> should be discussed with the VP of Girls Lacrosse.

Lacrosse is a game of high emotion and physicality. It is likely that during the season all parties involved- players, parents, and/or coaches will have concerns about something. When you find yourself in this position it is recommended to hold off for 48 hours in order to evaluate the situation. If after 48 hours you still have concerns, then it is time to talk. Most situations will be resolved themselves after adhering to the 48 hour policy.

ACADEMICS WILL BE FIRST. Your grades and class work come before lacrosse. Do your homework when you should. Directly after school is best. Our practices will be late so there is more than enough time to get your work done.

DO NOT WAIT UNTIL "THE DAY BEFORE" TO DO YOU HOMEWORK OR STUDYING, and school will rarely interfere with your lacrosse. You never wait the day before a game to start working out.

NO EXCEPTIONS:

- Bullying, hazing, and put downs of any sort will not be tolerated and will result in loss of playing time. 2nd offense will be removal from the team.
- The use of ANY smoking device will exult in removal from the team. Please do not start bad habits in high school.
- NO excuse policy with alcohol. 1st offense you will be removed from the team.
- ATTENDANCE. BE ON TIME FOR ALL PRACTICES. Be properly dressed in team gear, no
 jewelry, no long or acrylic nails. We know there are circumstances that will arise when you
 must miss a practice (illness, etc). When this occurs, the player is to inform their coach in
 advance when possible.
- Being grounded by your parents will be treated as an unexcused absence. Remember lacrosse is also a class and you will receive a grade so attendance is mandatory.
- Attitude: Our goal is to field a team of players that consistently demand more of themselves, Be positive, coachable, hustle and display mental toughness.
- All bags must be lined up straight at all games.
- We do not leave a facility until all trash is picked up. Tournaments, scrimmages, league games,etc.

- WE WILL WORK HARD Work hard to develop good habits by practicing with good form and appropriate effort. Use game effort during all practices.
- Respect teammates, referees, opponents, and coaches.
- Come to the coach first if you have a problem with the team. Complaining and excuses will
 not help the direction of the team. Let's focus on doing our best!

PARENTS

As a parent of the above-named player, I promise to do the following:

- Influence my child to abide by the contract signed
- If your child is having problems, such as academics or bad attitude, please contact the coach
- Be an example of good sportsmanship
- Be patient with coaches who are not giving your child playing time you feel she deserves.

- If an issue presents itself, set up a meeting to be the next board meeting with the board and head coach so we can professionally handle the issue after the 48 hour period.

COACHES

- Attempt to play each player every game. In close games, the time may be less (even no playing time) and in blowouts, the starters will probably play less than substitutes
- Be example of good sportsmanship and character
- Teach your child the skills to become the best player they can be
- Discuss anything with parents or players
- Address concerns after 48 hour period
- Prepare all players for college/adulthood
