Travel Softball

Travel teams are perfect for the players who can commit to more games and weekend tournaments. All 10u and 12U travel players will attend tryouts for team formation purposes. Every attempt will be made to avoid turning any player away*. Teams are formed based on their birth year, so a team may consist of 3 different grades. (Example: a 3rd grader with a 2011 birthday can try out for 10U and be placed on a team with other 2010 and 2011 birthdays.)

8U: \$260

2014, 2015, 2016 birth year

- Practices Monday and Wednesday, with games every Wednesday starting in May
- 2-3 weekend tournaments

10U: \$375 + Tryout Fee 2012 and 2013 birth year

- Player-Pitch
- Practices Tuesday and Thursdays, with a double header games every Thursday starting in May
- Season April—July
- 3-5 tournaments

12U: \$410 + Tryout Fee 2010 and 2011 birth year

- Player-Pitch
- Practices Monday and Wednesday, with double header games every Wednesday starting in May
- 4-5 tournaments

Recreation Softball

Recreational teams are perfect for players who are less experienced and prefer less weekend commitment. Recreation softball competition levels will match with other recreation teams. Rec teams WILL travel to surrounding communities for games*. Teams are formed based on birth year of the player. Try outs are not required and accommodations can be made on team formations based on age and grade level.

- Practice and games are Tuesday and Thursdays
- Season April—July
- Weather impacted practices will not be rescheduled
- One End-of-Season Tournament
