MATCH PREVIEW

Brooklyn Football Club travels to Hodges Stadium on Saturday afternoon to face league leading Sporting JAX, as the two sides meet for just the second time in their history. Their first encounter came earlier this season, when Brooklyn hosted a thrilling 3-3 draw, with Rebecca Cooke leading the way with one goal and one assist in a dynamic attacking performance. Since then, Sporting JAX have surged to the top of the table with 41 points, powered by the league's most prolific attack (42 goals). Nineteen-year-old Ashlyn Puerta has been second in the golden boot race, tallying 12 goals and five assists while driving play in the final third. Saturday's matchup also carries an added storyline, as former Brooklyn FC fullback Grace Phillpotts, now a regular starter for Sporting JAX, faces her former club. For Brooklyn, the timing is critical, with the team entering the final stretch of its playoff push and looking to turn flashes of quality into consistent results. Facing the league leaders on the road presents a major challenge, but also an opportunity to make a statement as the postseason race intensifies.

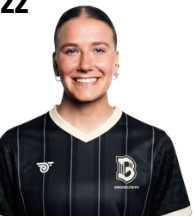
