2. Old Business
  - a. High School Booster Club:
    - i. Checks have been written and will be given to the High School Booster club for a one time donation for the boys and girls lacrosse teams.
  - b. Craft Show:
    - i. Clover Farms informed the board that they have donated their product for the craft show and will be refunding the expenses back to the club.
    - ii. The board felt the concession stand ran smoothly. The club did have some help from high school players towards their community service hours.
  - c. Purse Bingo
    - i. A few more purses/bags need to be purchased. Black Friday and Cyber Monday are approaching so this should not be a problem.
    - ii. Selling apparel at the event was talked about. Last year people inquired if any were for sale. Eugen said he would check with Rockhoud on turn around time. Items discussed were:

      5. Car Magnets
    - iii. The club is looking into Yeti fundraiser for the event and apparel sale. It was thought a gift basket could be made for a raffle at the bingo event.

    - i. A representative from the club will reach out to the coaches to invite them to a future meeting. The club would like to exchange ideas for the players and discuss expectations for players getting ready to play at the high school level.

    - ii. Boys teams need parent volunteers for game day operations (i.e. scorekeeper/running game clock) and other positions to be discussed

    - iv. Was suggested each team have a team manager (parent) to help coaches with communication with other team parents and coordinating volunteer positions.
