 - vi. Discussion regarding the PeeWee B/C for the two teams. It would create difficulties for a PeeWee C team to find games.

- vii. Ryan Egan comments— No easy solutions with numbers for Squirts based on numbers. Need to have enough numbers of kids for a team and there will be disparities between the top skater and lower skater (based on the tryout scores). Not fair to anyone to have a few kids show up at a tournament. Can have times on families can't / won't make it to games and tournaments. Would prefer larger team with enough skaters and focus on development. Squirt level will develop very quickly when skating with higher skill level kids. This disparity gap will close over time.
- viii. Chuck Weber / Ryan Egan Larger teams helpful to have more coaches to help the various levels of skill.
- ix. Will need to look at the break point in score to make sure kids are on the best possible team for their skill level.
