Notes:

- The Steel fell in regulation for the first time since Nov. 25, 2020 in a 7-5 loss to Team USA on Friday night at USA Hockey Arena ... Of the 12 total goals scored, nine goals accounted for either game-tying or lead-changing goals ... Chicago couldn't capitalize on its only power-play opportunity of the night ... The Steel notched their first game going without recording a penalty against in the loss ... Both clubs recorded 34 shots on goal.
- Steel forward **Matt Coronato** matched a historic USHL mark with a goal. Dating back to the 2019-2020 season, the Harvard-bound skater now has a 25-game point streak spanning two seasons which ties the all-time USHL overall point streak record.
- Rookie **Adam Fantilli** picked up his first-career multi-point outing with a goal and a helper. He now has five points (2G, 3A) on the year.
- **Josh Doan** registered three points (1G, 2A) in the loss. He now has 13 points (6G, 7A) in 16 outings this year.
- **Colton Huard** lit the lamp for the second time this season. The defenseman now has nine points (2G, 7A).
- Defenseman **Ryan Ufko** scored for the fifth time this season, giving him a total of 16 points (5G, 11A).
- **Jackson Blake**, **Jack Harvey** and **Sean Farrell** each tallied an assist in the loss.
- Goaltender **Nick Haas** made 27 saves but suffered his first loss of the season. He now has a 6-1-0-0 record between the Steel pipes this season.
