

Glory on the Grass Weather, Cancellation and Refund Policy

In the event of lightning, all teams shall clear the field and seek appropriate shelter. No teams are to take the field nor will games restart until the lightning and/or hazardous weather has left the area. No one should retake the field for a minimum of 30 minutes after the last lightning strike. For every new lightning strike, the 30 minute delay clock restarts.

If the tournament is suspended or delayed due to weather, field conditions or other situations outside of the tournament's control and if the matches being played have reached the 10th minute of play, those matches shall be considered complete and official. If the games have not reached the 10th minute of play, teams will be notified by the tournament personnel with further instructions.

In the event of inclement weather the day of the tournament, it is up to the discretion of the tournament director onsite to postpone, delay kickoff times, reduce game times or to cancel the tournament. Every effort will be made to complete the tournament. In the event of cancelation due to circumstances outside the control of the tournament host, no refunds will be provided. You will have the opportunity to transfer your registration to any remaining tournaments in the same calendar year.

If you register for a Glory on the Grass Tournament and your age group/division does not have enough teams registered to play, you will be provided with the offer to transfer your registration to any remaining tournaments in the same calendar year or a refund in full.

If a team withdraws after the tournament schedules are posted or does not show up to play on the day of the tournament, no refund will be provided.
