# 2020 Boys Youth Lacrosse Registration Is Open and Full of Change!

**Dear Braves Parents,** 

We are very excited for the start of spring lacrosse! There are so many changes at the Pre-K thru 6th Grade level that we believe will enhance the experience of you and your child!

We are now including the Little Laxers program as part of our K-2 program. We thought too many kids missed out last year because we sold it as an intro to the sport. It is! But it is also a great warm up for our more experienced players to have some fun with the game. I love the fact it is co-ed and families can have a morning of lacrosse together. Having our Varsity girls and boys give back by coaching is also invaluable.

We will continue to give away an EVO Warp Mini Stick to all our Pre-K thru second grade players. The stick handle is shorter and smaller and much easier to control. The pocket is pre-built, weather resistant and perfect. We want all of our Pre-K thru 2 kids using these. So many frustrations with the sport come from an oversized stick and an unforgiving pocket. For those that have already played and received a stick we will be offering a custom CA LACROSSE equipment backpack of equal value. If you would like additional sticks or bag, please note on your registration and they will be available at kickoff.

Our Pre-K players will complete the Little Laxer program and leave with a great experience and hopefully wanting more next year. Our Kindergarten players will continue meeting on Sundays with their age group as we add equipment while focusing on fun and fundamentals. The First and Second grade players will also meet on Sundays in the field house, add equipment and continue to focus on skills in a fun and active environment. If we have a miracle with a warm dry spring this age level will also have access to our box and turf field at this same scheduled practice time. We have made it a priority to eliminate cancellations and the fieldhouse will let us do this. Beginning May 12 our K-2 kids will head to the box lacrosse field to play small sided games that increase touches of the ball as well as fun. The ball always stays in play! This will take place every Tuesday and Thursday until the CA tournament. The K-2 boys will also have the option of attending two local tournaments free of charge.

Our Third through Six grade has some great changes as well. First and foremost, we are adding a Director of Lacrosse Instruction at the youth level. John Herriman worked with our program years ago building our current Varsity team as a youth coach. After spending several seasons as a successful club coach, he offered to come back to help build and maintain a championship program here. This starts with our youth! John will work daily with me at the Varsity level which allows me to in-turn stay connected to the youth through him. He will also "master" coach a weekly practice at each level staying in tune with the developmental needs of our kids. John is there to be a resource, providing our youth coaches with the latest player development models as well as being a non-parent administrator to decide team rosters.

Tired of the frustrating cancellation of practices and games last year because of weather and unplayable fields, we have decided to move the start of our season "indoors" and earlier than ever! We will begin our indoor practices on March 8. Our Sundays will take place in the field house at the Academy while Thursdays will be at Pinnacle Sports Complex in Victor. After spring break, we will go outside to play a 4-week in-house box lacrosse schedule. I can't stress to people enough how valuable the box experience is to player development. The repetition, skills, freedom and fun that kids find in the box can't be compared to the field experience. We are so lucky to have this facility. Our spring season will be completed on May 9th.

For those that want more we are offering a travel option. This will include Sunday practices after Spring break and eligibility for at least one travel tournament over the summer. There may be potential play dates with local

schools as well. These tournaments will be ala carte and you pay for what you play in. Coach Herriman will oversee the roster development of these teams as well and they will be coached by our youth staff as well as alumni home from school.

Even though we have added program, instruction and facility costs we have worked hard to not pass that expense on to you. This is why fundraising is important with our annual coupon card sale! Please reach out if money is ever an issue. We want every kid in Canandaigua to try out this great game. The youth are the life blood of our program and we will never forget that. Look forward to seeing everyone this spring.
