

2024 Mid-Season Tournament

COMMON RULES

1. Two Game balls will be supplied by the park for every game
2. **5** run limit per inning in pool play & bracket play.
3. Pool play **CANNOT** end in a tie International tie-breaker rule will apply.
4. If a player becomes sick or injured, his place in batting order will be skipped **WITHOUT** assessing an out. Game must start with min 8. If a game starts with 8 players, there will be 1 out assessed for the 9th batter. Can pick up only one player to 9 to avoid out.
5. Home team is the official scorekeeper. Visiting Team in the scoreboard.
6. Each Team will be allowed 3 Coaches Passes. Each Coach will sign in at the Gate.
7. No Smoking, Vaping or Pets allowed in the Park.
8. Seeding will be determined by W-L, Runs Allowed and then Runs Scored.
9. Home Team will be determined by a coin flip for Pool Play. In Bracket Play, Home Team will be the higher seed (1 v 2 - #1 is home team)
10. No Protest
11. **\$5 Gate fee Per Person (Fri). \$10 Gate fee (Sat). \$0 Gate Fee (Sun)**

8 and Under

1. Play all on defense. Bat all.
2. Pool play has a 60 minute limit. Must have a winner.
3. Bracket play has a 65 minute time limit.
4. No courtesy runner.
5. If a game is forfeited in Pool Play, the official score will be 5-0 to determine seeding.
6. **6U ONLY**: Last 3 hitters may hit off the tee. Not required. Must be declared before the game. Coach pitches 3 pitches and the tee hitter gets 2 attempts OR if Coach pitches 4 pitches, then the tee hitter will get 1 attempt from the tee. Coach must pitch at least 3 pitches.
7. **5U ONLY**: Every hitter gets the last pitch to hit off the tee. Last 3 hitters will have the same rule as 6U.

9 Thru 12

1. Play 10 on defense. Bat all. Free substitutions.
2. Pool play has a 65 minute limit. Finish the inning. Must have a winner.
3. Bracket play has a 75 minute time limit.
4. A courtesy runner must be used for catcher with 2 outs. Last batted out.
5. Coaches will be responsible for their team's pitching.
6. Any Rec rules will be carried over to the Tournament
7. If a game is forfeited in Pool Play, the official score will be 5-0 to determine seeding
8. 9/10 Only: 1 base per steal attempt. After an attempted steal beyond the original throw, any subsequent play on any runner on base will constitute another action and therefore extend the play allowing the runner to continue. (i.e. Attempted steal and throw- ball comes back to P and before P steps on the mound he makes a play on the runner by throwing to another base. Any runners on base at that time may advance bases.)
