Another great year in the books for our Marshfield Boys Hockey Teams! This year we had an unprecedented amount of parent volunteers and business sponsorships which both are the lifeline of our program. A driving force behind the success, is this overwhelming support of our sponsors and families. Their generosity and support allow 70+ hockey loving kids to wear a Ram's jersey and fill out rosters for three complete teams. This would be impossible without all the tremendous support and for that we are most grateful!

The Marshfield Boy's hockey teams had another successful season. The JV teams combined played close to 60 games and we were the only town to play that many games in a season. In addition to their regularly scheduled games, the JV Green and White teams participated in the Winter Classic (JV White Champs!), Green Cup vs Duxbury (JV White Win!) and the Sunday night Bog League (JV White Champs!). The Varsity team jumped right into their pre-season with a trip to CT for a scrimmage vs Darien and then on to the Garrett Reagan Summit. That was followed by the MHL Pat Serio Cup, Green Cup (Varsity Champs!), a once in a lifetime opportunity scrimmage at Fenway Park, Ed Burns Coffee Cup, and the D1 Massachusetts State Playoffs where they made an Elite 8 appearance. Varsity finished as the Patriot League Keenan Division champs going undefeated with a 14-0 record! Congratulations to Coach Connolly on his 350th win on January 27 versus Silver Lake!
