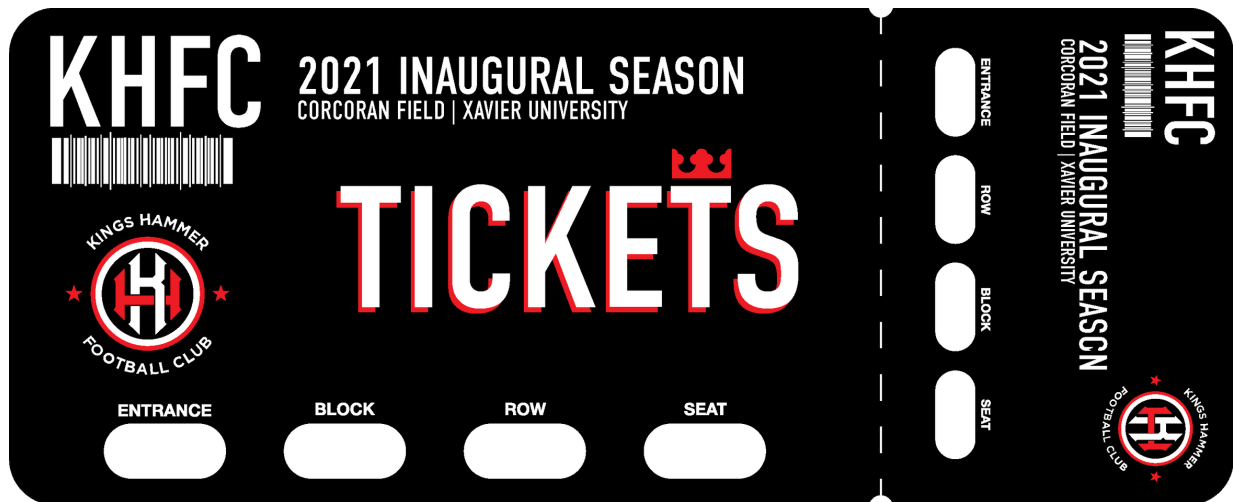
JAMIE STARR - GOALKEEPER COACH
