

Ground Rules for Sites

Apollo High School – All basketball hoops just meet the minimum 15 foot height from floor, so ruling will be part of ceiling (rule 8.4.2a, page 32).

American Sports Center in Avondale – No special rules

Apache Junction High School – No special rules in main gym.

ASU PE West Gym – Basketball hoops/back boards will be ruled a judgement replay (rule 8.4.2a, page 32)

ASU Student Recreation Center Gym - No special rules

Atkinson - Hanging partition if 15 feet or higher will be considered part of ceiling (rule 8.4.2a, page 32). If hanging partition is lowered below 15 feet, then it will be ruled a divider separating courts and only the player playing the ball may move it (rule 9a, page 34). Basketball hoops/back boards will be ruled a judgment replay (rule 8.4.2a, page 32). Change of playing surface by court 4 (west court) will be ruled out of play (rule 1.2.1, slippery surface page 6).

Barney Family Sports Gym - No special rules

Buckeye High School - Basketball hoops/back boards will be ruled a judgment replay (rule 8.4.2a, page 32).

Carson Jr High School - Backboards affixed to the West wall will be ruled a judgment replay (rule 8.4.2a, page 25). No spectators allowed to sit on the West side of the gym. Only exception will be made for wheelchairs and video cameras. Team camps on Playground only.

Catalina High School – courts are too close together when three courts are being used. Players are not allowed to enter adjacent courts after playing the ball, but can play the ball while behind the end line of adjacent courts (rule 9b, page 34). No official stand on the middle court.

Central Arizona College - No special rules other than make sure there are center lines.

Chandler Gilbert Community College at Williams Field - No special rules

Court One – Hanging dividers separating courts may only be moved by the player playing the ball (rule 9a, page 34). When gym is setup to allow maximum number of courts, then pillars are

ruled a judgment replay (rule 8.4.2a, page 32 or 10.1.2, page 37). On some courts you have the potential for judgment replay because of the walkways being close to the court (rule 8.4.2f, page v33). Courts on north side of gym have hanging banners that are considered part of ceiling – play on. Change of playing surface by South East court will be ruled out of play (rule 1.2.1, slippery surface page 6). Also concerning South East court, the server shall be on the playing surface to receive authorization for service (rule 12.3 and 12.4.3, page 40)

Embry-Riddle - Has screens that if moved while playing the ball, must be by the player, not a teammate (rule 9a, page 34). Overhead baskets are all high enough to be play-on when above 'playable area'(rule 8.4.2a, page 32). Playable area extends to walls, bleachers, and tournament desk.

Greenfield Junior High School - No special rules

Highland High School – unknown

Kroc Center/Salvation Army – Hanging partition if 15 feet or higher will be considered part of the ceiling (rule 8.4.2a, page 32). If hanging partition is lowered below 15 feet, then it will be ruled a divider separating courts and only the player playing the ball may move it (rule 9a, page 34). Running track underneath will be ruled ceiling, play on. Running track side wall and supports will be ruled wall

Marcos de Niza High School – Only one ref stand available for four courts. Small gym - courts are 3-4' from wall down the sideline are ruled out for time purposes.

Mesa Community College – Only one ref stand available for four courts. Small gym – no issues. Main Gym – courts are too close together, players are not allowed to enter adjacent courts after playing the ball, but can play the ball while behind end line of adjacent courts (rule 9b page 34).

Mesa High School – Large over hang wall by benches will be ruled a judgment replay (rule 8.4.2a, page 32). Auxiliary gym does not have enough room behind end lines for serving. If possible a line should be marked on the court to provide the minimum depth (rule 1.4.2, page 9). If a line can't be established, then an agreed upon method should be made clear to all officials and coaches (example: only one foot may enter the court when serving, the second foot may be on the line). Auxiliary gym, since courts are 3-4' from wall down the end line are ruled out for time purposes.

Mountain View High School - unknown

Palo Verde High School – Main gym bleachers are declared out of bounds. Small gym hoops are declared part of ceiling

Phoenix Community College – unknown

Red Rock High School - unknown

South Mountain Community College - No special rules

Spiral VBC Gym – Courts that have pillars too close are ruled a judgment replay (rule 8.4.2a, page 32 or 10.1.2, page 37).

Tempe High School – All basketball hoops as well as a pull down screen (court 2) meet the minimum 15 foot height from floor, so ruling will be part of ceiling (rule 8.4.2a, page 32). Auxiliary gym does not have enough room behind end lines for serving. If possible a line should be marked on the court to provide the minimum depth (rule 1.4.2, page 9). If a line can't be established, then an agreed upon method should be made clear to all officials and coaches (example: only one foot may enter the court when serving, the second foot shall be on the line, but not enter the court) All courts are 3-4' from wall down a sideline and/or end line are ruled out for time purposes.

Wickenburg High School – Only one ref stands for four courts

Westwood High School – Basketball hoops/back boards will be ruled a judgement replay (rule 8.4.2a, page 32)

Yavapai Community College – No ref stand for the middle court. Score table for the middle court is placed at the end of the court.

Youngker High School - Hanging partition if 15 feet or higher will be considered part of ceiling (rule 8.4.2a, page 32). If hanging partition is lowered below 15 feet, then it will be ruled a divider separating courts and only the player playing the ball may move it (rule 9a, page 34). Air ducts in main and auxiliary gym are considered part of ceiling (rule 8.4.2a, page 32).
