#### "HIGHLANDER PROGRAM" Game Rosters:

- 17-20 Players will dress for each Varsity Team Game.
- 15-20 Players will dress for each Development Team Game.
  - (Original assignment to Varsity or DEV Team is <u>NOT</u> permanent & <u>Players</u> are moved between teams based on daily Effort, Attitude, & <u>Production</u> throughout the season)

### "HIGHLANDER PROGRAM" Games:

- 25 regular season + Playoffs for Howell Varsity Team.
- 23 regular season + Playoffs for Howell Development Team.

### "HIGHLANDER PROGRAM" Practices:

- 2 Days of Try-outs.
- 55-65 Regular Season Practices
- "HIGHLANDER PROGRAM" After Try-outs: (this will vary season to season based on players available)
  - 9 or 10 Forwards 6 Defensemen 2 Goalies will be assigned to the Varsity.
  - 10 or 11 Forwards 6 or 7 Defensemen 2 or 3 Goalies will be assigned to the DEV Team.
  - o These assignments are **NOT** permanent and do **NOT** guarantee playing time.

## "HIGHLANDER PROGRAM" Assignments:

- Being assigned originally to the DEV Team or Varsity is <u>NOT</u> a permanent assignment.
- Dressing for either team is a privilege not a guarantee and every dress list is earned.
- o Dress lists will be announced at least 24 hours prior to each game.
- Unlike AAA or Travel Hockey, Players are <u>NOT</u> guaranteed to dress for any game. Each dress list is a daily
  competition and must be earned every day in the community, classroom, practice, workouts, video study,
  and in games. "Effort & Attitude" matters within the "HIGHLANDER PROGRAM".
