

Winter 2021 Athletic Attendance Policy

Spectators Policy

The policies defined below are in strict accordance with the Covid-19 policies established by the Minnesota Department of Health, Minnesota State High School League and the Suburban East Conference.

BOYS AND GIRLS ALPINE SKI – No spectators allowed at this time per event facility protocol

BOYS AND GIRLS NORDIC SKI – To be determined by host community venue

BOYS SWIM AND DIVE – No spectators allowed No exceptions due to capacity restrictions

GYMNASTICS - No spectators allowed No exceptions due to capacity restrictions

DANCE – 1 family member per athlete will be allowed due to the size of the teams, spectators must adhere to the following guidelines

- Each student athlete will be allowed one spectator, the family must purchase an SEC dance pass for \$40
- The pass must be presented when checking in for the event, the passes will be for sale at the activity's office
- Spectators can only be in the gym during their school's performance. When East Ridge is not performing our spectators will be cleared from the gym
- **Face coverings required** at all times
- **Seating** is expected to be 6' apart unless you are with a family member
- If spectators refuse to follow these guidelines, they will be asked to leave the event

WRESTLING – 2 family members per student athlete are allowed and must adhere to the following guidelines:

- Student athlete must be listed on the official roster
- Each JV and Varsity athlete will be allowed to 2 tickets for the days event
- The 2 spectators will need to check in at the entrance of the gym
- Tickets will be \$5 and sold on site, the ticket will be good for both matches that day
- Spectators can only be in the gym during their schools wrestling event. When East Ridge is not wrestling our spectators will be cleared from the gym
- **Face coverings required** at all times
- **Seating** is expected to be 6' apart unless you are with a family member
- If spectators refuse to follow these guidelines, they will be asked to leave the event

BOYS AND GIRLS BASKETBALL – 2 family members per student athlete are allowed and must adhere to the following guidelines:

- The student athlete must be listed on the official roster
- 9th grade and B squad are allowed 2 spectators (family members) **at home games only**, free admission.
- Each JV and Varsity student athlete will be allowed to purchase 2 spectator passes for family members only, **passes are not to be given to students.**
- Passes will be for sale for \$100 per pass, they can be purchased on our registration system, [click here](#) to access the site.
- **The pass is good for home and away games, you must present your pass when checking in at the game.**
- **Face coverings required** at all times
- **Seating** is expected to be 6' apart unless you are with a family member
- If spectators refuse to follow these guidelines, they will be asked to leave the event

BOYS AND GIRLS HOCKEY – 2 family members per student athlete are allowed and must adhere to the following guidelines:

- The student athlete must be listed on the official roster
