



### Championship Weekend




- July 8<sup>th</sup> through the 10<sup>th</sup>







### Reporting Scores

### **Umpires**



- Begin at Squirts 2
  - Instructional levels for Umpires
  - Help them with positioning and rules, NOT JUDGEMENT CALLS
- Expectation of coaches:
  - Work with the umpires
  - Let them do their jobs
  - Treat them with dignity and respect
  - Keep your cool, no matter what
  - Provide CONSTRUCTIVE feedback when reporting scores
- You are responsible for fans, players, assistant coaches

### Umpires – Part 2

- We teach professionalism
- We don't teach them to eject people, BUT . . .
- Profanity, constant questioning, referring to on-line rule books, trying to take over games will cause issues
- Do NOT expect perfection
  - No umpire is perfect
  - Your rule knowledge is likely not perfect
- Remember that they are kids
- We have THEIR back




#### Rainout Procedure



- League Cancellations
  - Notification from the website
  - Emails/text messages
- Rain Out Procedure
  - Head coach responsible for checking field
  - Contact visiting coach to discuss field conditions
    - Voicemail/e-mail is not considered good contact for postponement of games
  - Contact age-level umpire coordinator ASAP to cancel the umpires
  - Reschedule game as soon as possible, this is the responsibility of the home team. Contact the league director if you are the visiting coach and are having trouble getting a game rescheduled


# Lightning

- If you can see it, it's too close
- Suspend play
- Cover fields
- Get kids to cars/shelter
- 30-minute game delay
- Game clock does NOT stop!

  continuations allowed after
  2 innings

## What if I won't have enough players

- 8 players by game time and/or be able to finish the game with 8 players.
- "Make the call to the minors."
  - 1 level below your current level in current in-house program
  - Try for the higher age of a combined level, if possible
- Rules for Substitutes
  - Must wear their team uniform
  - May not pitch
  - All other participation rules apply
  - Do not start a substitute over a rostered player

#### What if I still can't field a team?

- Must be MORE THAN 72 HOURS before the game
- Contact the other coach and gain agreement for the reschedule
- If possible, determine a make-up date
- Contact the umpire coordinator to reschedule the game, fields and umpires

### Game Logistics

- Coaching Staff know the rules
- Base Coaches Know the rules for advancing runners
- Bench Coach Keep batting order, ensure players are ready to hit (on deck), keep order on the bench
- Pitching Coach Make sure they can throw strikes
- Head Coach Keep the game moving by having players (defense, catcher) ready. Keep your cool, set an example.

### Global Rules – All Age Levels

- NFHS Rule Book
- Runner Interference
- Obstruction
- No appeals
- No head-first sliding (Ponies and below)
- Only the starting pitcher can re-enter the game as pitcher, and only one time.
- 3 charged defensive conferences per game

#### Pitch Counts

- Maximum number of pitches per-game and per-week
- In addition to inning maximums
- BOTH coaches are responsible for tracking pitch counts for BOTH teams
  - Verify pitch counts after each inning
  - Home team counts are official
- If a pitcher reaches the limit during an at-bat, he can finish that at-bat.
- Continuation games
  - Pitch counts continue from when the game was stopped.
  - Weekly pitch counts apply for the week in which the game is resumed.



#### Minors

- Continued Changes
  - 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grade combined
  - · Partnering with Eastview
  - Play by Minors 5 rules
- Stealing
  - Lead-off after the ball crosses home plate
    - Player must return to the base when the pitcher has the ball on the rubber.
  - Stealing allowed after the ball crosses the plate
- Pitching
  - Distance: 46 feet
  - No breaking balls
  - 3 innings max per game, 6 innings per week
  - Pitch count: 75 per game, 105 per week
- 6-run limit per inning, unlimited in the 6<sup>th</sup> inning.
- 2-hour time limit
- Bat Restrictions:







Minors coaches, have a great season!

### Majors

- Player agreement
- Full lead-offs and stealing It's a live ball!
- · Infield fly and drop third strike are introduced
- 7 innings
- Balks!!
  - Teach your pitchers
  - · Umpires will be watching
- Pitching
  - Distance: 52 feet
  - 4 innings max per game, 8 per week
  - Pitch count: 85 per game, 115 per week
- Sliding is not required, but runners must avoid contact
- 6-run limit per inning, unlimited in the 7<sup>th</sup> inning.
- 2 hour time limit
- Bat Restrictions:
  - 2-1/4": Unlimited drop
  - Big Barrel: -10
