

Important information you should know about DIBS:

- Each player family Mite 2/8U level 2 through Bantam/15U is required to fulfill volunteer hours every year
 - Single player families are required to fulfill 8 hours
 - Multi-player families are required to fulfill 12 hours
 - Each player is assigned the requirement of 8 hours at the start of the season
 - If you have 2 players, you will receive a “multi-child credit” for 4 hours against the second player. Both players will show requirement of 8 hours (16 total), the credit will show 4 hours against the second player leaving 12 hours for your family to fulfill. You should show BOTH players completed 8 hours each at the end of the year to meet the requirement.
 - If you have 3 players, you will receive a “multi-child credit” for 4 hours against all 3 players. All 3 player will show a requirement of 8 hours (24 total). Each player will show the 4 hour credit and your family will be responsible for fulfilling 12 hours. All 3 three players should show with 8 hours complete at the end of the year to meet your requirement.
- Your email must be tied to your players profile in order to sign up for DIBS. Check out the “How Do I” page on the FLHA Website for help on updating your account.

- Helping with team activities (i.e. always doing clock at home games, ordering team apparel, etc) or *Concessions DOES NOT count for DIBS hours.
 - *Concession coverage is usually a requirement for all levels of play and it does not count towards player DIBS. Due to COVID-19 protocols, this will be re-evaluated as needed.
- Tryouts are the first offered DIBS hours every year, these go fast. Don’t worry if you cannot get your hours in during Tryouts, there are plenty of other opportunities throughout the year.
- If you plan on Managing or Coaching (Head or Assistant) please consider leaving the early Tryout Dibs for other families who don’t typically fill these roles.
 - Team hours are distributed as such, these hours are *NOT transferrable and cannot be split*. Team managers are required to provide the names/roles to DIBS Coordinator by December 1st.
 - **Head Coach** – 12 hours
 - Must be registered on FLHA website, on official USA Hockey Roster and completed ALL USA Hockey requirements
 - **Assistant Coach**, up to 3 per team – 8 hours each
 - Must be registered on FLHA website, on official USA Hockey Roster and completed ALL USA Hockey requirements
 - **Single Manager** – 12 hours
 - OR
 - **Co-Managers** – 8 hours each
 - OR
 - **Single Manager and Single Scrimmage Coordinator** – 8 hours each
 - All managers/scrimmage coordinators must be registered on FLHA website and complete official USA Hockey requirements (background check and SafeSport)
- If you plan on coaching/managing multiple teams, please consider allowing others to volunteer for one of the teams if there are others interested.
 - Again, your team hours cannot be transferred or split
- If you are currently on the Board or a Committee, consider allowing other parents to coach/manage as your hours are fulfilled through your Board or Committee position.
- Consider joining a FLHA Committee or applying for open Board positions for future years
- Consider choosing the Volunteer Buyout option during Registration next year
- ALL DIBS MUST BE RECONCILED BY END OF THE SEASON, NO ADJUSTMENTS WILL BE MADE AFTER THE SEASON HAS ENDED.
