Parent Code of Conduct

Thank you for being a part of the East County Revolution Football Club, ECRFC. Below is our Parent Code of Conduct, which we expect you to abide by, as it will be enforced by our coaching staff and club officials. Please make sure to read through and understand that this is a condition for participation in ECRFC.

1. As a parent, I agree to support the ECRFC in requiring the players to abide by the ECRFC Player Code of Conduct.
2. I will abide by any ECRFC Rules and Guidelines, along with Norcal Premier Soccer and US Club Soccer Policies, Rules, and Regulations:
3. I understand that part of my commitment to ECRFC competitive soccer is to devote my time during the season towards volunteerism within the team and/or club if requested or needed.
4. I agree to present myself as a positive role model while representing ECRFC at any soccer game, tournament, or training session.
5. I agree to only praise players at any team game, tournament, or training session. I will respect the fact that this game is for the players, not the parents, and will only provide positive communication from the sideline.
6. I will refrain from any form of negative communication or confrontation with the opposing team's parents and players.
7. I will refrain from coaching my own or any other child during the course of a game.
8. I will refrain from communicating with the referees before, during, and after any game.
9. I will discuss any constructive concerns I have about players or the program in the following order: Coach first, Director of Coaching second, and finally with the club's Grievance Committee.
10. I understand that the coaches, managers, and directors are dedicated to providing a quality soccer experience through training and team events. As a parent, I am committed to making every effort to get my child to all training and team events.
11. Line of communication with the coaching staff: As a parent, I will always respect the coaching staff during all games and training. I will never question, discuss or confront the coach during or right after any game. I understand that a '24 hour cooling-off period is in effect and that I will only approach the coaching staff after 24 hours. I further understand that my child will first approach the coach to discuss any on-field issues. Should this not resolve the issue, I will set up a parent/player/coach meeting.

I agree that if I fail to abide by any of the rules listed above that I may be subject to, but not limited by the following disciplinary action:

1. Verbal or written warning
2. Suspension from attending games, tournaments, and training
3. Expulsion from the team/club
