

MBA 6U League Rules

Ground Rules

- 1. All players on roster will bat during each half inning.
- Batters and runners must wear helmets and should wear their caps beneath, avoid rashes, lice, etc.
- 3. No metal cleats are allowed
- 4. Catchers must wear helmets, make sure catchers are back far enough from the hitter.
- 5. Baserunners may not lead off. No stealing allowed.
- 6. Try to have kids avoid head first slides
- 7. The first 4 sessions will start with a tee for each player. If the coach determines a player is ready for coach pitch earlier, feel free to make that decision. Give each player 5 pitches, if the ball is not put in fair play, take the tee out and have the batter hit from the tee.
- 8. No extra bases will be taken on any overthrows, including first base.
- 9. There is no infield fly rule.
- 10. No bunting allowed.
- 11. The last batter can only advance bases based on rules, we won't have them "circle" the bases because they are last.
- 12. Use throw down bases in each bag. This age group does not need to be at 70 foot bases. Walk off roughly 40-45 feet and point it out to each player.

Rotations/Playing Time

- 1. All Players on the roster will bat each half inning
- 2. All players on the roster will remain in the same batting order throughout the game.
- All players on the roster will play in the field each inning. Each team will rotate players to different positions each inning. Give opportunity to each player as much as possible.

Games and Practice Schedules

- 1. Each practice or game shouldn't go over an hour in length.
- 2. Try to complete a full inning for equal time for each team during games.
- 3. All games will be held on fields 1 and 8 at Eastview. (2 closest fields to School Blvd)
- 4. All games and practices will be 1 night a week, starting in May and ending in June.
- 5. Coordinators will make decisions on rain outs, they will contact the coaches and it's the coaches responsibility to contact their team.
- 6. There will be no make up days for missed games or practices.
- 7. Coaches will do umpiring.
- 8. Coaches will distribute all schedules and fundraising sheets to families and be responsible to collect fundraising sheets. Coordinators will come to collect sheets at the deadline date.
