- Scholarship funds are allocated from TFC fundraising associated with FHS sports and activities.
- All applications must be returned to the FHS Guidance Office no later than 12:00 noon on May 5th, 2024.
- Athletics / Activities participation and violation-free verification will occur after that time.
- Scholarship applicant names will be redacted and replace by an applicant number after verification of eligibility by FHS.
- The selection committee will be basing their decision on the merits of the application without knowledge of who the applicant is.
- Scholarship winners will be announced at the FHS Senior Awards Banquet on Wednesday, May 31, 2024.
- Scholarship monies are available after the winner presents verification of their first term attendance at the post-secondary institution of their choice to the Tiger Fan Club through the FHS Athletics and Activities Office. Verification might include a copy of grades, letter from registrar, campus housing receipt or similar proof of attendance or school related expense confirming attendance.
