

REFUND POLICY (PLEASE READ)

It is the policy of Impact Soccer Club to refund registration fees only if your player moves more than 50 miles from his/her primary residence prior to the start of the season, or if the player is unable to participate due to a season ending injury or illness as documented by a physician before the midway mark of a season.

No refund, credits or fee transfers will be allowed for any other reasons. If Impact Soccer Club is unable to place your child on a team, a full refund will be issued. Conflicts with practice schedules are not grounds for refunds. Refund requests due to injury must be made within two weeks of injury or illness, and must have a physician's note included. There will be no reimbursements granted for any programming cancelled due to weather, acts of God, or forfeits.

Note: When Impact SC extends an acceptance offer, the club is choosing this roster to be filled by this player over other players. The club uses player fees to pay the rent of facilities, insurance, league fees, tournament fees, and all other necessary costs which are a part of travel soccer. The club does not receive a reimbursement from many of these fees, so depending on the timeline of the season, the club will be unable to offer full refunds at certain times of the season.

IMPACT SC TRAVEL ACCEPTANCE

I acknowledge that by checking the box and completing the online registration that I am 18 years or older and accepting the offer for my son or daughter to be a player for Impact SC. I fully understand that I am committed to the club for a one year term and that the club has the right to hold the player to the one year commitment and not allow transfer to a competing club during the **2025-26** soccer season. I understand the fees are non-refundable.

COMMITMENT

If I elect to leave after registering with Impact SC, and before completion of the full season commitment, there will be no refund of fees and the player will be unable to participate in the **2025-26** season with any other club.

NPL, ECNL, NL, etc. COMMITMENTS

Many of the teams qualify for Supplemental Leagues & Tournaments/Showcases that require commitment by the team. Forfeits and withdrawing from the leagues or tournaments come with fines to the club. By checking this box, you agree these fines will be charged to the members of the team in the event that the team withdraws from a league or tournament unless it is a Club decision. Examples of fines and penalties below are from the Cup Game Tournaments for Indiana Soccer. This includes a team not producing enough players to participate in an advancement stage of a tournament such as Cup Games.

Rule 204. FORFEITS FOR FAILURE TO COMPETE

Section 1. Withdrawal from Competition

- (1) Any team that withdraws from these competitions after having entered the competition, but before the Cup selections/seeding (State & Presidents Cup) or draw (Challenge Cup), shall not be penalized.
- (2) Any team that withdraws after the brackets have been posted, but before the schedules have been officially published, shall forfeit its registration fee.
- (3) Any team that withdraws after the schedules have been officially published shall forfeit its registration fee and may be suspended from all Cup competitions for the following Cup year. The Club to which that team belongs to shall be fined \$500.00.

Section 2. Missing Games

- (1) Any team missing a particular game during any Cup event for any reason shall forfeit their entry fee, and the Club to which that team belongs shall be fined \$500.00. The game will be recorded as a forfeit.
- (2) Any team who forfeits a game in Preliminary Round play for any reason, will not be allowed to advance to the Semi-Final/Final round of competition.

THE INDIANA IMPACT ALLin POLICY

As a player for the Indiana Impact Soccer Club, I agree to be "All In" with the Club and not participate in competing leagues with another club. As an Impact SC player, I will honor my commitment to my team and my club before all else. Further, as all players will have both USYS and US Club player cards, I understand, by reading this, it is illegal to participate with other clubs without authorization from Indiana Impact SC. This does NOT include, ODP, Winter indoor leagues or Rec tourneys (such as Coerver 5v5 or Roll Out the Barrel).

NOTE: All in (#ALLin) is more than a hashtag, it is a culture and a commitment. It means as players learn skills, tactics, develop socially, physically and mentally, we also want to teach kids the value of hard work, commitment and loyalty.
