Anticipate a reduction in credits for graduating classes (24 vs 26) – won't impact college, state requirement is 22.5, trimesters made room for the additional credits.

SAT Test - potentially to be offered in several sessions to allow for social distancing, no dates yet. Most Universities have currently abandoned this requirement and essays.
