BASEBALL PEI 11U “A” RULES

Roster Rules

- Players must be 11U-aged, meaning they turn 11-years-old or younger during the calendar year of 2022.

Game Rules

- Follows Baseball Canada 11U rules except for the following adaptations:
 - o All games will be five (5) innings long.
 - However, if the game is still taking place after one hour, forty-five minutes, the inning the game is currently in will be finished, and no new innings will be started.
 - o Each inning will end with three (3) outs, or four (4) runs scored, except for the fifth inning, which is an open inning (a team can score as many runs as possible before three outs are recorded).
 - o 9 Players will play on the field, and a player can't play the same position twice in one game.
 - o There is no pitch count in effect at the 11U “A” level. However, each pitcher is only allowed to pitch a maximum on one (1) inning per game.
 - o A player will throw the first five (5) pitches to a batter; if the batter has not hit the ball, or has not struck out, the coach will come in and throw up to three (3) more pitches. If on the third pitch the player hits a foul ball, they will get one more pitch. If the batter still does not have a hit, the batter will be deemed out.
 - If after five (5) pitches the coach comes in to throw three (3) pitches, the count that the batter has after the five (5) pitches will remain. In other words, when the coach comes in to pitch, the count **will not** return to 0-0. There will be no exceptions to this rule.
 - o There will be no base-on-balls; however, if the batter is hit by a pitch – by a player, not a coach – they may take first base.
 - o Umpire will call strikes when a player and coach is pitching, and strikeouts are possible.
 - o Baserunners will not be permitted to take lead-offs, steal bases or advance on passed balls, or advance on balls out of play or in foul.
 - o Baserunners cannot score unless batted in; scoring on an overthrow is not permitted and the baserunner must stop at 3rd base.
 - o Bunting will not be permitted.
 - o All games will be played using Rawlings R850 baseballs.
 - o New 11U bat rule: For minus 5 and above, all aluminum bats can be used. It shall not be more than 32 inches in length, and max barrel up to 2 3/4 inches with 1.15 BPF (Bat Performance Factor). Bats may be taped to a distance not exceeding sixteen (16) inches from the handle (comes from the Baseball Atlantic Manual, section 5.5).

Provincials Eligibility

- The regular season must be completed no later than 14 August 2019, and the Provincial Jamboree will be from 25-29 August 2022.
- Teams must play each game of the schedule in order to be eligible for the Provincial Championships.

Miscellaneous Rules

- After each game (deadline: 8 am the next day) the home team must record the game score, names of pitchers for both teams, and the name of the umpire on their team webpage.
- The home team is to provide one (1) brand new R850 baseball for each game, and two (2) good “second” balls.
