



Morris-Benson-Area GOALIE COORDINATOR JOB DESCRIPTION

The Goalie Coach Coordinator is responsible for the growth, development and recognition of Morris-Benson-Area(MBA) goaltenders.

Responsible to:

The Goalie Coordinator works with the Coach Coordinator and directly reports to the MBA Hockey Operations Committee and Joint Board.

Responsibilities and Duties:

The Goalie Coordinator should:

- Commit to 1-2 practices a week during the season to work with goaltenders at all Levels
- Commit to 1 day a month for goaltender specific practice for all levels
- Create a database of goaltenders to continue training throughout season and development
- Meet coaches and Coach Coordinator monthly throughout season
 - Goaltender Updates
 - Training Recommendations
- Attend the MBA joint board monthly meetings to review
- Focus on goaltender development for long term success
- Coordinate hockey development efforts with boys and girls goaltenders at all levels

Knowledge and Skills Required

A Goalie Coordinator is someone who:

- Can communicate effectively and has good interpersonal skills
- Has competed or coached at a consistent or higher level of hockey, ie: Varsity Hockey, Juniors, Collegiate or higher
- Demonstrates a strong knowledge and understanding of hockey development specifically surrounding goaltenders
