Executive Reports:

President - I believe the 2023 baseball season is going to be exciting and challenging at the same time and I believe a review of our Committee and Division assignments is due now that we will also be renewing the Rule Book for 2024.

We, the BCMBA BoD, are going to have much explaining to do as the year goes on due to the fines being voted out of Rule 11.02. The rule, now without a fine, makes the NCCP requirements mandatory for BCMBA Post-Season play which includes all postseason zone play and/or playoffs leading to the Provincial Championships and the Provincial Championships themselves of course. NCCP Coaching levels for Baseball BC qualifiers to Westerns and Nationals will be subject to Baseball Canada and Western Canada requirements.

This messaging must be and will be shared with all BCMBA members prior to the Convention in February where we will be working with Baseball BC in making as many modules available as we can.

I am also hoping that we, (James), can create a ticket system through the website for Appeals, Discipline, Eligibility, Mergers, etc. so we know what's pending and what's been put to rest. The idea behind this is mostly due to a number of Discipline events unheard or not dealt with until very late this year. See New Business.
