### Lift Tickets

Buy individual tickets through the Nashoba Valley Ski
 Area online ticket system

Or, buy season passes, \$600 through December 15

 On practice nights, buy discounted ticket at Nashoba, mention racer name at window, \$45.00

Race day, buy discounted ticket at Nashoba, \$70 4 hour ticket


Cost savings strategies - multi-packs and gift car

For consideration when deciding

8+ practices planned, plus 4 home races (\$640)

Of course, weather could cancel some dates
If you live nearby, a pass is worth considering





#### **Practices**

- Head coaches
  - Adam Schayowitz (U8)
  - Glen Gaebe and Jon Weintraub (U10-U19)
- Practices -
  - Thursdays 6:30 8:00 for U8, 6:30 8:30 U10 and older
  - No practice during vacation weeks (12/30 and 2/23)
- Racers should have ticket, be on the snow and ready to go
- Notes about Equipment reference NVSC website
- Typical practice routine
- What happens if my racer gets hurt?
- U8 racers receive a practice bib which they bring to every practice

#### Behavior

- No pole fighting, tackling, etc. violations, will be asked to leave
- The ski areas do occasionally pull tickets for violating their policies







### First Practice

- Arrive early to be ready and possibly get in a couple warm up runs
- Waivers
  - No waiver, no on-snow participation!
- U8 racers will pick up their practice bib which they bring to all practices
- Meet up with your Pod
  - Pod assignments will be distributed ahead of first practice
  - Limited requests for groupings are possible, do this early
- Practice starts at 6:30pm sharp!
  - All racers should be with lift ticket/pass, fed, watered, on snow and ready to go at 6:30 sharp!
  - U8 practice ends 8:00pm, parents/guardians must be outside to pick up their racer(s)
  - U10-U19 ends 8:30, racers are released on their own

## Races Days

- Race every Sunday from January 8th through March 5th except the first weekend of February vacation (2/19)
  - Two types of races for U10-U19: GS and SL
  - Modified GS for U8
- The typical home and away race
- Course inspections
  - Some coaches will be on hand for races
- Racers must know the race order and which course the run on
  - Seed list and course assignments usually sent the night before each race







## Races Days (continued)

- Award ceremonies follow the conclusion of each race
  - Results to be posted online as always
- If Nashoba closes for any reason, practice or a race will be canceled
  - Conversely, if the ski area is open, the event is on!
- Equipment needed (or not needed)
  - o race suits, **helmets**, chin, shin and hand guards
- Pay attention to communications daily, before each race
