1. **Entries:** PT Timing will be providing online entry services for the Sectional meet. Coaches will have until Tuesday, October 22 at 11:59 p.m. to enter on-line. Any school that misses the entry deadline will still be allowed to enter but their reimbursement will be withheld if their team or individual(s) qualify for the State Meet. 6. **Ticket price for spectators**

\$5.00 per person in the vehicle, excluding children 12 and under and senior citizens. This will be collected when parking your vehicle. Programs will be sold for \$1.

***Spectators** are to park in Lot 8 and 9 (by the dorms), Lot 11 (Williams Center), and Lot 24 (Stadium).

***Buses** need to park in the Perkins Stadium Lot (Lot 24) only.

9. We will have an athletic trainer on site provided by Mercyheath Sports Medicine.

10. There will also be portable bathrooms located near the start line for all to use. There will be locker room access in the General Locker Rooms inside the fieldhouse which will have access to showers as well. Coaches are responsible for their athletes. No spikes are allowed in the fieldhouse.

11. No dogs allowed. Please let your parents and fans know this.

12. Teams are required to set up their tents close to the DLK Fieldhouse away from the starting area and concessions.

13. Those qualifying for the 2019 WIAA State Cross Country Meet will include:

a. The first 2 teams

b. The first 5 individuals who are not members of the qualifying teams
