
Off-Season – High School Athletes

 - A and B schedule





 - Screening includes offenses involving a minor, use/possession/sale of controlled substance, use or threats of violence, sexual offenses, illegal gambling & financial crimes





Player Expectations


- Attend practice

Playing Time - 5th + 6th Grade


- Playing time is dependent upon position and number of players at the position
- Fair playing time for players who work hard, accept coaching, and regularly attend practice
- Players will be trained in one offensive and defensive position
- Player development is prioritized over wins and loses
- Teams will be split evenly into two teams by coaches



Playing Time – 7th + 8th Grade


- Players must earn their spot
- More emphasis is placed on winning than at 5th
 + 6th grade
- Players will play both offense and defense
- Players who attend practice, try hard, and are coachable will get playing time

 Siblings will be aligned on either Blue or Gold teams



Playing Time


- With a roster of 35 kids...
 - 11 will play at a time (~30%)
 - 24 will be on the sidelines (~70%)
- With a roster of 75 kids
 - 11 will play at a time (~15%)
 - 64 will be on the sidelines (~85%)
- The Braves will progressively prepare Mukwonago football players for their high school experience



Parent Expectations

Communication with Coaches

- Abide by 24-hour rule






Summer Camp Dates

- Summer camps are led by MHS football coaching staff



- Open to all Braves & Indians families


