CONCUSSION PROTOCOL:

Every coach involved in school sport needs to complete the on-line concussion course "Concussion in Sports - What you need to know". There is no cost to register and you complete the course through schoolcoach.ca. At the end of the course, each individual is provided with a printable certificate. The certificate number for each coach should be entered into the coach information section of each E-5.

COACH EDUCATION:

On behalf of Sask Sport, SHSAA continues to request that every coach (head coach, associate coach, or assistant coach) involved with a school team complete the Respect in Sport for Activity Leaders on-line training. Upon completion of the three hour course, each individual is provided with a certificate number which schools enter into the coach information section of each team registration. Once training has been completed, it does not have to be repeated in future years. When registering for the course, please select Saskatchewan High Schools Athletic Association as one of the sponsor groups.
