Notes:

- The Chicago Steel lost 2-1 in overtime against the Green Bay Gamblers on Friday night at Resch Center in Wisconsin ... Chicago earned seven power play opportunities but could only reach the back of the net once (14.3%) ... The Steel penalty kill registered a 4-for-5 (80.0%) performance in the overtime loss ... Both Chicago and Green Bay racked up 32 shots on net through regulation and overtime.
- With a point earned for the ninth consecutive game to start the year, the Steel can match the longest point streak to start a season in franchise history on Saturday, Oct. 23 against the Dubuque Fighting Saints. The 2016-2017 Steel went 10 consecutive games without a regulation loss to open the season before advancing to win the franchise's first Clark Cup.
- **Jack Harvey** tallied his sixth goal of the season, a power play marker, pulling into a tie for first among Steel goal scorers this season. The Boston University commit now has nine points (6G, 3A) in as many games this year.
- **Jackson Blake** extended his point streak to six games (5G, 10A) with a helper in the overtime loss. **Blake**, a Carolina Hurricanes prospect, leads the USHL with 16 points (6G, 10A) during the 2021-2022 season.
- Steel defenseman **Jake Livanavage** pushed his assist streak to four straight games, the longest point streak of his USHL career. The University of North Dakota-bound blueliner leads Steel defensemen with seven points (7A) this year.

- **Gibson Homer** made 30 saves in net and now has a 2-0-3-0 record between the Steel pipes. It was third game this season with 30 or more saves and third performance with two or fewer goals allowed.
