This is our inaugural championship event for the state chapter of our national organization, USAYESS. As with all USAYESS events, this tournament is open to all youth teams and individuals belonging to any youth organization and college team with a competitive youth shooting program. USAYESS or National Governing Body (NGB) memberships are not required.

We will do our best to finish on time. This will be based on the time it takes athletes to finish their rounds, shoot-offs, weather and equipment. Please don't dilly dally between rounds, especially in SKEET.

SAFETY: Eye and ear protection are mandatory. Headphones are not considered ear protection. No release triggers. No toe pads or resting muzzle on the foot. No hands resting on muzzle. Actions open when moving. Semi-autos must be facing forward and upward. Over-

unders broken open and pointed forward. No alcohol consumption on property while any shooting is going on, practice or competition.

COURSE OF FIRE: Skeet: 25 targets. Trap: 50 targets.

Sporting Clays: 100 targets.

ELIGIBILITY: All FLYESS tournaments are open to shooters belonging to any youth organization, club or school team, college and below. Fees vary for members and non-members. In order to receive USAYESS discount, the team must be an active USAYESS member and all athletes on that team must be active USAYESS members.

SQUADDING: A legal squad is five shooters from the same team and in the same division. Any athletes bumped up to a higher division, will remain in the bumped up division in all of the tournaments events, individual and squad. If a team is not able to attend the event, yet one of the team's athletes would like to compete, they may. Individuals qualify for all individual awards.

<u>AWARDS:</u> Squad awards will be presented to the top three squads in each division and each event. The top three individual athletes in each division and each event. High Over All (HOA) will be presented to top team, top individual man and top individual lady regardless of division. TO QUALIFY FOR HOA AWARDS, TEAMS/INDIVIDUALS MUST SHOOT ALL 3 EVENTS.

AMMO: 7 1/2, 8 and 9. FishHawk Sporting has ammo on site; call the ProShop for brands and pricing, 813-689-0490.

PRACTICE: The White and Green courses are available for practice and warm up. Target Keys can be purchased at the ProShop.

CART RENTAL FEES: \$55.00 per day.

Liability Waiver must be completed per athlete before shooting.

Registrations after March 6 add \$10/event.

A competitive squad for squad awards consists of 5 athletes. Athletes should compete in their appropriate current grade group. Bump up from a lower division to the next division up is allowed to create a competitive squad. Once bumped up, that athlete will remain and compete in that division throughout the entire tournament in all events, including any and all individual events.

Athletes can shoot as individuals. Athletes can compete in one or more events. For High All Around, athletes must compete in ALL events.

No prior tournament qualifications are required. No NSSA, NSCA, ATA, USAS or any other membership is required. Participants do not need to become members of USAYESS in order to compete but non-USAYESS membership fees may apply. Refunds allowed prior to March 6, minus \$5 service fee.

Lunch: Noon-1 p.m. Light lunch meals will be available. Prepaid Lunch tickets paid with entry fee for athletes. Non shooters, guests \$10. \$12 if paid on day of event.
