No jewelry is to be worn while playing soccer and is to be removed prior to the start of each session.

Players are to remove hats (e.g. no baseball hats), sunglasses and any other items deemed unsafe for soccer.

Cultural & religious coverings, such as head scarfs and kippahs, are allowed by Ontario Soccer.

Players to wear uniform provided, and the ball distributed to your child is pumped and sent with them to every session.

Spectators sit on outside of fields 2 metres away from edge & not in space between fields (reserved for coaches & players).

Other than service animals, the Club does NOT recommend bringing any pets (including dogs) to soccer.

Per City Field Permits, all dogs need to be always on a leash & 5 metres away from the playing fields and other spectators.

Pursuant to Ontario Soccer regulations, scores and standings are not recorded for Under 12 and younger.

Practices or games cancelled due to inclement weather will not be scheduled.

Soccer format is 3v3 (3 players on the field from each team); No goal keepers

Kick-in instead of throw-in (can not score directly from a kick-in); No Corner kicks

No corner kicks; when the ball goes out across the goal line,

the defending team either side of the gets to restart the play with a kick-in, either side of the net about 1m to 2m from the goal line No off-side; Retreat line for U5/U6 Full rules at https://www.westrougesoccer.ca/outdoorrules
