WHO ARE THE COACHES?

Dedicated volunteers who are passionate about teaching young players the game. Coaches are provided administrative & training curriculum support throughout the year by the Director and full time Classics Eagles leadership team. Coaches are provided coach education, session plans, licensure opportunities, and mentorship throughout the year. **Head coach's child's fees are waived.** Discount can be split among multiple coaches.

WHERE DO WE PLAY?

Practice - Teams are provided practice areas in the Olentangy (Lewis Center / Powell / Westerville) areas. Teams typically practice two times per week.

Leagues – Teams play in local leagues in the Columbus, Ohio area. Home games are at community parks, and away games are played at your opponent's home field.

Tournaments – Teams play in a local end of season league tournament.

Optional – Teams have options to play in additional local or non-local tournaments based on Director guidance and the team's competitive preferences.

ADDITIONAL SKILL and GOALKEEPER TRAINING

Throughout the year, players will be able to attend supplemental training sessions to enhance their skill level and confidence. These sessions will be led by Professional Coaches during the Fall and Spring seasons. These sessions are offered at no additional cost and specialize in ball skills training for field players and goalkeeper specific training for goalkeepers.

SUPERKICK PARTNER BENEFITS

Through our partnership with SuperKick, Classics Eagles teams have priority on winter field and court rental reservations, and will receive a discount on rentals.

WHAT IS THE CE WAY? #CEWAY

The CE Way is the values the club operates by to ensure a positive experience for all players, parents, and coaches within the program and outside of it. It is based on the value of RESPECT for each other, our opponents, the game, and our community. We take OWNERSHIP of our actions and the experience we create for ourselves and others we interact with on and off the field.

WHAT IS THE COST?

\$595 for the full year includes (does not include CC processing fees):

- Player Registration Fees
- League Entry Fees (2 seasons – FALL & SPRING)
- Referee Fees (10 per season)
- End-of-Season League Tournament Entry for Fall and Spring (2 total)
- Game Field and Training Facility expenses
- Professionally Led Preseason Camp
- Fall Pre-season Inter-Club Scrimmages
- Spring Pre-season Team Practices at TOCA
- Professional Coach Led Skill Training Sessions
- Professional Coach Led Goalkeeper Training Sessions
- Parent/Player Professional Support Services
- Team Coach Resources (Gear, Equipment, Education/Licensure)
- Dedicated Administrative Support to Teams and Coaches
- Single Season is \$300.

UNIFORMS

Uniforms are purchased separately and are good for two-year cycles with the new cycle starting on each odd year. For the Fall 2023 & Spring 2024 seasons, **ALL** players will need to purchase uniforms. This is the first year of a new two-year uniform cycle and uniforms will be good from Fall 2023 through Spring 2025 (4 seasons). The cost of the average kit is around \$200 for required items.

CAN YOU ADD MORE?

YES! Classics Eagles Soccer Club is designed to be flexible to meet each individual team's seasonal needs and goals. Coaches can work with the Director to map out a seasonal plan in terms of leagues, tournaments, training, winter indoor space, and additional opportunities. Options outside of what is included in the cost of the program would be an additional fee.

- Player Assessment for Players Looking for Teams - current Classics Eagles players do NOT attend.

- Team Camps: Week of July 31st to August 5th (evening)
- Team Preseason Scrimmages: August 5th and 6th
- Fall Season – August 1st to October 30th
- Winter – November 2023 to February 2024 (no official team events)
- Winter Indoor Spring Pre-Season Sessions at TOCA Columbus – March 2024 (mid-March)
- Spring Season – March 18th to May 31st 2024
