





Provides a master license to RCX Sports to administer NHL Street.

### **RCXSports**

Vets and approves organizers to run independently licensed leagues.

No upfront franchise/license fee.

Provides official leagues administrative, marketing and promotional supports.



Operators include municipal recs, YMCA, BGC, Private orgs.

Charges family reasonable league fee (~\$75 - \$200) in line with geographic expectations and comparable sport experiences.

A per capita fee (~\$25 USD) is paid from the operator to RCX to cover the cost of branded uniforms and other swag.

Provides data back to RCX/NHL.



Provides a hockey experience to their children that is affordable, low pressure and works with their schedule.



Participates in a fun experience, makes friends, stays active and healthy.

Feels connected to the NHL brands.



#### PLAY IT ANYWHERE

- Game designed to get back to hockey roots, where most of us started, in our driveways, streets in front of our house, and parks in our community
- Rink dimensions are flexible, to fit in to nearly any available space
- NO HOCKEY RINK/FULL BOARDS REQUIRED!
  - Tennis courts, basketball courts, and open parking lots are perfect playing surfaces for NHL STREET
  - Boards/barrier only required directly behind the nets.

### MINIMAL EQUIPMENT REQUIRED

- The only piece of equipment a player needs to participate, is the stick itself! No other equipment required, and no need to know how to skate!
- While players are always welcome to bring their own stick, NHL Street asks its operators to have some spare sticks on hand for student athletes to borrow as needed

### AFFORDABLE FOR BOTH PLAYERS AND OPERATORS

- No recurring or annual franchise fee for operators. RCX Sports/NHL Street operates on a per-player business model, starting at \$25 per player
  - Player fee includes a fully licensed NHL Street jersey for every player, utilizing any team logo and colors from within the NHL the operator selects.
  - All jerseys are fully sublimated, and fully reversible, to ensure there is never an issue of 2 teams wearing the same color!
- If an operator needs equipment, NHL Street and our partners at Franklin Sports can provide preferred pricing on any items you need!

#### CREATES MORE ACCESS TO THE GAME THAN EVER BEFORE

- NHL Street brings a low pressure, low cost access point to the game of hockey, allowing more student athletes and parents to give the game a try!

### Rink Dimensions

MINIMUM: 60'X30'


• Slightly smaller than a tennis court

• MAXIMUM: 95'x50'

 Roughly the size of a basketball court

- Smooth, flat hard surface
- EXAMPLES: Concrete, asphalt, hardwood, vinyl, sport court etc.







- ALL PLAYERS GEAR
  - Hockey stick
  - Athletic shoes
  - NHL STREET team shirt
- GOALIE SPECIFIC GEAR
  - Leg pads
  - Glove & blocker
  - Chest pad
  - Goalie mask

### • NOT REQUIRED, BUT PERMITTED IF DESIRED

- Helmet with cage
- Gloves
  - Ice or street hockey protective gloves
- Shin guards
  - Hockey
  - Soccer

### NOT PERMITTED

- Skates
- Elbow pads
- Shoulder pads
- Ice hockey pants
- Ice hockey goalie equipment

- Net sizes may vary based on age group and availability




NET GUIDELINES					
Size	Width	Height	Sqft. Of net	NOTE	
Minimum	46	40	12.78	Most appropriate for players up to 10 years old	
Standard	50	42	14.58	Playable at all youth age groups	
Maximum	54	44	16.5	Most appropriate for players older than 14 years old	
NHL	72	48	24	Not recommend for NHL STREET applications
