**March**

**7v7/Spring Gear Store**

\$75

All players are required to purchase a gear set that typically includes one compression shirt, one short, and one T-shirt. Budget cost for one set of **required items** is \$75; personalization extra

**Strength and Agility Training Fee**

\$100

Coach Zupke coordinates an outsourced training with **Speed and Strength University** that happens during the PE for Athletes class at school. All athletes attend and are invoiced for the training.

**BSN Fan Gear Store**

Nike branded fan gear goes on sale mid March and is completely optional.

**April**

**Player Gear and Nike Store**

\$20+

Nike Cleat and accessory store typically opens the second week in April after Nike's product launch - item pricing is discounted from retail due to Pinnacle being a Nike branded school. All items included are completely optional. Coach Zupke requests predominantly white cleats for Varsity players. Cleat prices start at \$80, gloves at \$30, mouthguards at approximately \$20 each. While mouthguards are not required to be purchased through team sales, they are required to be worn at every practice and game. Athletes are required to wear a 5 or 7 pad girdle during the fall tackle season - girdle pricing starts at \$40.

**JV/Varsity Phon-a-Thon**

This event is required for the players to attend and is handled by an outside entity. The audience is geared toward supporters who are not immediate family of the player. The next door neighbor, the great aunt in Texas who loves to watch the games on YouTube or the piano teacher who brags about her star piano student playing football are the target audience. Our football program has a revenue sharing agreement with the third party vendor of these two fundraisers so a portion of the proceeds are delivered to the football program. No investment is asked of the players' guardians from this event.

**May**

**Frosh Team Phon-a-Thon**

This event is required for the players to attend and is handled by an outside entity. The audience is geared toward supporters who are not immediate family of the player. The next door neighbor, the great aunt in Texas who loves to watch the games on YouTube, or the piano teacher who brags about her star piano student playing football are the target audience. Our football program has a revenue sharing agreement with the third party vendor of these two fundraisers so a portion of the proceeds are delivered to the football program. No investment is asked of the players' guardians from this event.

**Helmet Sales**

VICIS helmet program orders typically open the second week in May and close within 10 days. These helmets are completely optional and typically priced around \$700-\$800 depending on type and size. If a player owns their own helmet, certification must be current; if certification is needed it takes approximately 8 weeks and cost \$120-\$175. Approved, certified helmets can be check out from the team equipment manager at no cost.

**Shoulder Pad Sales**

Every other year (odd years) shoulder pad sales could be scheduled. The current vendor, X-Tech, is not scheduled to be on campus but orders can be placed if so desired. We can provide you with their contact information. Pads are typically priced around \$500-\$800 depending on accessories. These pads are completely optional. Approved, certified pads can be checked out from the team equipment manager at no cost.

**Sports Physical**

\$15+

Banner Sports Medicine holds a group physical event to assist with the **mandatory physical required** by the Aktivite/Register My Athlete system used by PVUSD for all athletes. Cost for the physical is \$15 at the event or approximately \$25 at any valley wide NextCare/Urgent Care location. Personal physician physicals are price dependent on insurance and office charges.

**Mandatory Parent Meeting and Membership Night**

\$220+

The Pinnacle Football Booster club holds membership night to explain the current season schedule, events and for Coach Zupke to bring everyone up to speed on expectations and changes. Membership Night is also where families join the booster club, pay for the **\$400 JV/Varsity camp attendance** and the **estimated \$120 player fund**. The Pinnacle Football booster club is comprised mainly of parent and guardians of football players and 100% of the membership donations are delivered to Pioneer Football Inc, a 501(c)(3) charitable organization, and in most cases are tax deductible. **Memberships range from \$100-\$1000.** That organization buys gear, pays training and travel fees and supports our athletes' season. **Strength and Agility Training**

\$200

All players are required to participate in **summer strength training** unless excused by Coach Zupke. Registration is handled through Community Education as a district led camp and typically runs end of May through July.

## June

### San Diego State University 7v7 passing tournament

The spring varsity 7v7 players will be evaluated based on position need and performance from April and May events then approximately 20-30 players will receive an invitation to travel to San Diego via charter bus to compete. Cost for the trip is typically \$60 plus meals and incidentals.

## July

### W.H.O. Fan Gear Store & Nike Fan Gear Store

Pinnacle football fan gear stores open and items are completely optional. Delivery dates vary by product.

### JV/Varsity Football Camp

For JV/Varsity. Remaining balance due from membership night for the JV/Varsity football camp must be paid by July 17th.

## August

### Team Photo Day

All Pinnacle Players are required to attend for media guide and roster photos. Packages typically range from \$8 - \$60 however, no purchase is necessary unless personal copies of the photos are desired.

### PVUSD Athletic Fee

\$200

PVUSD requires that each Pinnacle athlete pay a \$200 athletic fee to be cleared to play. This amount can be offset with the Arizona tax credit and has a maximum family investment of \$400 per year. For example, I have two kids in two sports but after I pay the athletic fees for football (\$400 for the two kids) when the season for track starts I send an email to the Athletic Director's office noting my previous payments and the additional \$400 for the two kids to participate in track and field is waived.

### Savings Card Sales

All Pinnacle Players are required to sell savings cards (number to be determined). Cards are typically sold for \$25-\$35 and the target audience is less well known neighbors and community residents. Door to door sales and social media sales are encouraged. Our football program has a revenue sharing agreement with the third party vendor of these two fundraisers so a portion of the proceeds are delivered to the football program. No investment is asked of the players' guardians from this event.

Varsity team banquet ticket prices are typically around \$50 per guest. All athlete tickets are complimentary.
