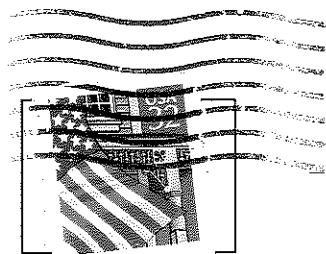

GAME SUMMARIES

PLANTAGENETS VS. PRIME TIME- GAME 1

But after that only 5 more hits. Then with the score 4-1 in the 7th it all fell apart for Prime Time. Bottom of the 7th, hits by Goldenberg, Dweck, Jesse, and Labo and a big blow by Jemal (a 3 run double) and the Plantagenets scored 4 runs with no outs as they gain a sweep. The red hot Plantagenets need a sweep and some help to make the playoffs.

CRACKER JAX VS. FIDDLER- GAME 2

The Cracker Jaxs were out to avenge their only loss of the season as they played the 2nd game of the double header from 3 weeks ago. Shomer's Goof won the first game and looked to continue its magic. As for the Jax, they knew no team could beat them 2 times in one season and the only question was how many runs will they beat the Goof by! Gindi was nearly perfect starting the game with 4 shutout innings, allowing only 3 hits. By then the score was 8-0, thanx to Buzzard as he hit a 3 run homer and a RBI single and a sac-fly as he finished off with 6 RBI's and 3 hits. His brother, Jaydee, was 4-4 with 4 runs scored, giving the Dweck brothers a stat line of 7-7, 7 runs scored, 5 singles, 1 double, 1 Hr, and 7 RBI's. The Goof mounted a late comeback, scoring 9 runs in the last 3 innings, but it was too little, too late as the Jax continue it's dominance in YMSL, going to an "astounding" 13-1. As for the Goof a 6-7 mark puts them in a tie for the last playoff spot with the Force as the 2 battle each other next week.

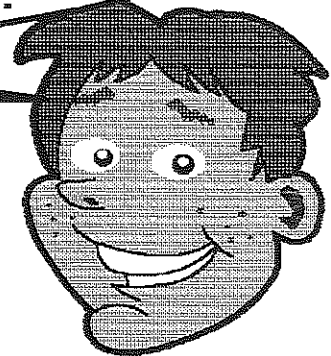
THE WHO VS. MAMA'S BOYZ- GAME 2

YMSL- Would you ever play for him again?

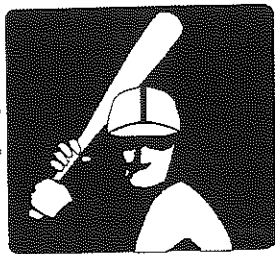
RN- Let's put it this way, you'll see Michael Salomon pay cover charge for a club before you see me play for this captain again.

RN- What's the big deal? I'm a big Happy Days fan. I think he's cooler then Potsie.

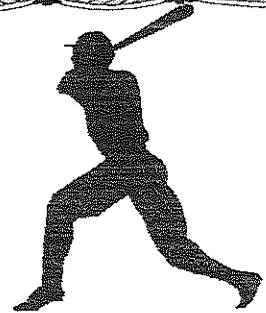
YMSL- What about Ralph Malph?

RN- I used to like him, but he reminds me of my captain.



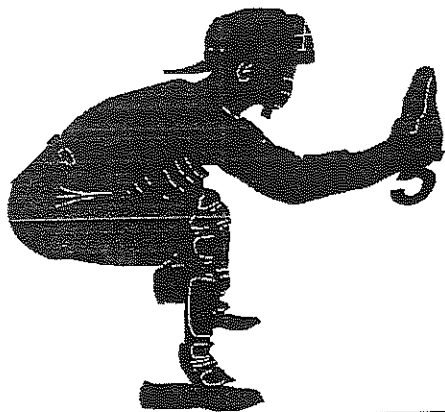

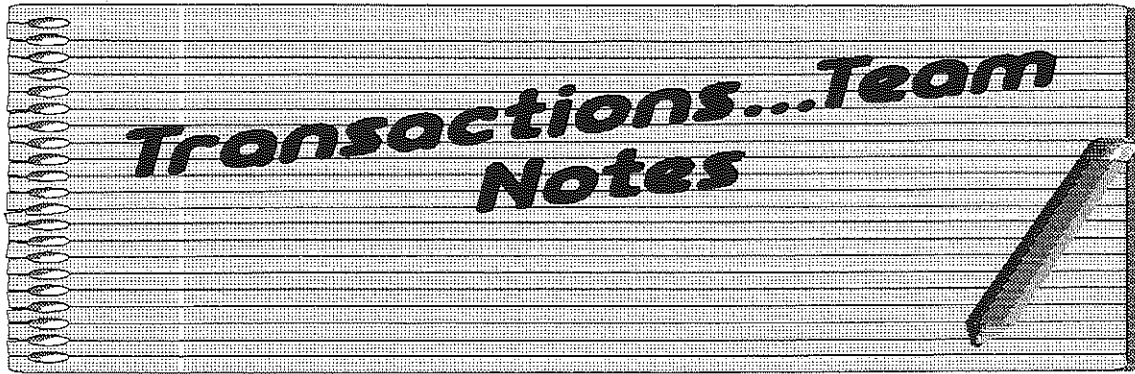

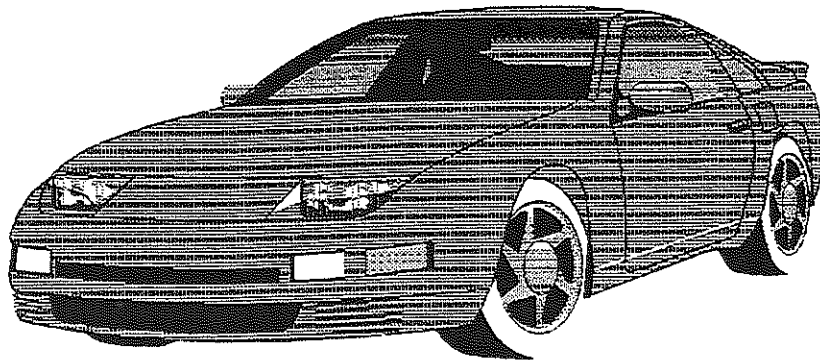
