Coordinator and National Office staff to enhance the quality and consistency of compulsory routines, contributing to a strong and unified national standard.

# **Required Qualifications**

- Experience choreographing for a variety of ages and abilities.
- Strong communication skills and a collaborative mindset.
- Strong public speaking skills and confidence presenting to large groups.

#### **Preferred:**

- Understanding of gymnastics technique, posture, and performance quality.
- Ability to break down movement in a way that is clear, teachable, and age appropriate.
- Demonstrates strong attention to detail in both planning and execution.

- 1. Resume
  - o Include relevant coaching, choreographic, or gymnastics experience.
- 2. Statement of Artistic Approach (Max 500 words)
  - o Share your perspective on how to build artistry and technique in young gymnasts.
