

Saint of the Week: St. Barnabas

We first hear about **Barnabas** in the Acts of the Apostles. Though he was not one of the original twelve, Barnabas took on the missionary role of an Apostle. Barnabas introduced Paul to Peter and the other Apostles, and they were sent out to bring the good news of God's love to the Gentiles. It was not always an easy journey. They were kicked out of some cities and villages who did not want to hear what they had to say, but Paul and Barnabas were undeterred and continued on their mission. Barnabas teaches us to listen and discern what it is we are being sent out to do, and to be steadfast even when the mission may be difficult.
