- II. Welcoming remarks - Troy Creurer
 - o Hockey season is coming fast and furious, so need to get organizational items together
- III. Approval of 8/23/22 Meeting Minutes

 - o Scoresheets for Q games or regular games must have a ref signature to be a legitimate game
