## 2021-2022 Rules Affected by Waiver Bylaw 4.2.3.C

- Beginning in the 2022-2023 season, the three-point line will be set to 22-1 ¾ as per the 2022-2023 NCAA Rule Book
- Shot Clock Reset. The NCAA rules resetting the shot clock to 20 seconds after an offensive rebound shall NOT be enforced on <u>live or dead ball situations</u> for the 2021-22 season. The following scenarios affect this ruling:

## A. Live Ball Scenario

A1 Shoots the ball. The ball hits the rim and is rebounded by A2. Shot Clock resets to 30 seconds <u>as per waiver for 2021-2022 Season.</u>

## B. <u>Live Ball Scenario</u>

A1 shoots the last of two free throw attempts. A2 secures the free throw rebound. Shot Clock resets to 30 seconds <u>as per waiver for 2021-2022 Season.</u>

## C. Dead Ball Scenario 1

A1 Shoots the ball. The ball hits the rim and B1 knocks the ball out of bounds. Team A retains possession. Reset the shot clock to 30 seconds <u>as per waiver for 2021-2022 Season.</u>
