

1. Award Categories

Each recipient receives a plaque.

- a) "Commuter Award"
Awarded to the member who commutes to and from work the most days during the calendar year.
- b) "Mens's To/From Award"
Awarded to the member who accumulates the most mileage riding to and from Club events.
- c) "Women's To/From Award"
Awarded to the member who accumulates the most mileage riding to and from Club events.
- d) "Men's High Mileage Award"
Awarded to the member who accumulates the most Club mileage (not including To/From mileage).
- e) "Women's High Mileage Award"
Awarded to the member who accumulates the most Club mileage (not including To/From mileage).
- f) "Men's Service Award"
Awarded to the member who accumulates the most activity points.
- g) "Women's Service Award"
Awarded to the member who accumulates the most activity points.

2. Mileage Award Requirements

Each recipient receives a certificate.

- a. An Official OCW Club Ride is one published in the Newsletter and/or the Ride Calendar, having an OCW Sign-In Sheet with Release & Waiver, and an OCW Route Slip.
- b. Mileage is computed at one (1) point per mile for OCW Club rides, and/or one (1) point per mile ridden while planning, and route slip verification/checking.

3. Service Award Requirements

Each recipient receives a certificate.

- a. Officers do not receive activity points for time spent related to their job but do accrue points for time spent listed in section (b).
- b. Activity Points are computed at ten (10) points per hour or as follows:
 - i. 800 - Managing an OCW Major Event.
 - ii. 100 - Support Crew on the OCW AMTRAK or BREATHLESS AGONY Century (per day).
 - iii. 75 - Being a featured speaker at an OCW General Meeting.
 - iv. 50 - Support Crew on any other OCW Major Event (Spring & Fall Metric Century).
 - v. 50 - Hosting an OCW Bicycle Social (BS) Party.
 - vi. 50 - Making a bicycling-related presentation to any outside club, society, or similar group.
 - vii. 35 - Writing an article published in the OCW Newsletter.
 - viii. 25 - Being an OCW committee member (per meeting session).
 - ix. 25 - Assisting an OCW Officer.
 - x. 25 - Leading an OCW ride.

- xi. 25 - Course Sweep on an OCW ride with a minimum of five riders.
- xii. 25 - Attending a Board Meeting, Bicycle Social (BS) Party, or General Meeting.
- xiii. 50 – Creating a new ride accepted by the Ride Captain.
- xiv. 75 - Completing Smart Cycling or other approved League of American Bicyclists course requirements.
- xv. 75 – Completing all 3 sessions of Cycling Savvy road safety class.
- xvi. 50 – Class room presentation of Cycling Safety class.
- xvii. 75 – Conducting Road Skills & Parking Lot drills.
