The #'s in boxes represent how many players should be in the wall when the ball is set in that area for a set piece. The "+ 1" represents an extra player if the set play is indirect. That player will stand approx. 1-3 yards from the wall on the far post side and charge the shooter as soon as the ball is touched. The wall should be set with the tallest player covering the near post. If the set piece requires 5 or more in the wall, make sure the wall is made up of your tallest players (defenders). As the set piece play moves towards the flanks (most likely a serve) you want your defenders in the box to win the serve. Keep in mind you may want an additional player in flank pieces when the opponent places two players on the ball.
