This position will be offered to the best candidate who exemplifies the qualities and direction that our club needs and who is best to develop our players' potential while leading them to be the best young men and women they can be, both on and off the ice.

Ideally, this position would start immediately to include the 2020 spring hockey season.

General Job description:

This position requires that applicants demonstrate the ability to lead by example, provide long term player development and above all the ability to engage and encourage our players to become the best players, teammates, leaders, and members of our communities or wherever they may end up in the future.

Required qualifications:

- High school diploma
- USA Hockey active registration
- USA Hockey CEP Level 3 or higher coaching certification
- Completion of USAH Age Specific modules, specifically the 16/18/19 & Under module
- USAH Safe Sport certification
- USAH Federal mandated background check certificate
- Excellent oral, written, and organizational skills
- Demonstrate current use of USA Hockey Coaching strategies, practice plans, drills, and skill development
- Commitment to long term player development
- Ability to organize and supervise all levels of a high school hockey program
- Demonstrate years and levels of experience at head coaching hockey positions at Bantam level or higher

Job duties, (not limited to):

- Comply with all USA Hockey, AHAI, and LZMW Hockey Club rules, policies, and regulations
- Organize yearlong activities for the development of the players, including pre-season fall, fall season, playoffs, pre-season spring, spring season, summer sessions both on and off-ice related to player development
- Serve as the club representative at school and community events to promote and drive recruitment opportunities
- Develop the club's recruitment and promotion plan for gaining new players
- Model and reinforce positive behaviors and enforce policies with regards to sportsmanship, hazing, bullying, language, alcohol, drugs, tobacco, and vaping.
- Ability to show positive reinforcement to players, board members, parents, and community

- Responsible for care of facilities, both home and away
- Responsible for creating a safe environment for players, both home and away (including locker rooms)
- Develop and organize common hockey strategies, practice plans, and skill development for both varsity and junior varsity teams
- Develop and administer a continuous off-ice and off-season program
- Develop double-rostered players for full time moves to next playing level
- Provide players with mid-season and end-of-season feedback
- Hold all coaches and players accountable for attending practices, off-ice practice, games and service projects
- Evaluate assistant coaches and playing personnel by attending at least one (1) team practice per week for junior varsity team and one (1) team game per month for junior varsity team
- Implement other job related duties as needed, as assigned by the LZMW Hockey Board of Directors
- Delegate staff assignments to assistant coaches, as necessary
- Maintain fiscal responsibility as it pertains to the coaches budget
