- Our boys' volleyball schedule is announced [on the website](#). Tournaments start in December and then will rotate throughout the northwest. All teams are invited to learn more about the [Border Smackdown](#) in May, hosted by the Evergreen Region. It's one of the largest USAV-sanctioned boys' events in the area.

- [Adult tournaments](#) begin next month with an event in Salem, followed by an October tournament in Tigard. All you need to play in September is a USAV membership. Indoor 6v6 tournaments will feature a tournament director, prizes, officials, and will partner with a local non-profit to help them gain exposure and community awareness.
- CEVA is seeking coaches to help run after-school volleyball clinics at elementary schools in the Portland area.
