### **CASA TRAVEL TEAMS**

CASA continues to support its many Travel teams as they work hard indoors in preparation for an exciting Spring season. Once again, CASA thanks its amazing coaching staff led by Technical Director Richard Chinapoo and Assistant Technical Directors Gino Di Florio (Elite), Chris Hartman (Girls), and Tom Mellor (Boys). CASA wishes its current coaching staff of 18 professionals and its 29 Travel teams much development and success as the Spring season begins! CASA's Travel program is for the player (age 8 to 19) who is looking to make an increased commitment to learning and understanding the game of soccer. All Coaches are licensed professionals and teams are on 1 Year Commitments.

Travel soccer requires playing games outside the club in a local league with home matches on CASA fields and with away matches against other clubs in the Central Pennsylvania area. Generally speaking away games are within an hour radius. Based on the abilities and the ambitions of the team there could be travel to local, regional or out-of-state tournaments.



The CASA Elite program offers our highest level of competition and is designed to meet the needs of players seeking superior competition and exceptional level of play. Players in the CASA Elite program possess a high level of skill, advanced knowledge of the game and tactics, commitment to team and its players as well as high work ethic. The CASA Elite program is designed for players who are generally interested in playing beyond high school at either the collegiate or professional level. CASA Elite teams compete in regional level leagues and tournaments. Those tournaments may frequently require travel and hotel stays, but these events will provide players with exposure at the regional and national levels.

CASA forms new Travel teams in the Spring of each year through open tryouts. Players are accepted to their team for the season year commitment beginning August 1<sup>st</sup> and ending July 31<sup>st</sup>. Numbers permitting, each year CASA Travel teams are formed for both boys and girls from U8 through U19.

# **CASA 2020-2021 TRAVEL TRYOUT REGISTRATION INFORMATION**

We are excited this year to be able to conduct our normal tryout process starting on May 1st. We thank you for the patience exhibited through the pandemic and the forming of our teams for the 2020-2021 season. CASA will be forming teams from the U9 to U19 age groups, with tryout registration available starting March 15. Our teams continue to play in local leagues, inter-state leagues, tournaments, state cups and college showcases.

- CASA is participating in Kids First Initiative. No tryouts will be held prior to May 1<sup>st</sup> for current U9 and older teams. Coaches for 2021-2022 teams will be known prior to tryouts.
- All CASA Tryout Registrants must pay the non-refundable \$20.00 tryout registration fee.
- A separate team registration fee will be considered at players acceptance to a CASA team and become due at the time of team assignment.
- If a player is offered a team roster spot and wishes to not accept this team roster spot, CASA must be notified in writing within 72 hours of being offered a team roster spot.



For planning purposes, next year's Travel and Elite team camps are planned for the following dates:

- U9 (2013) and U10 (2012) Boys/Girls Travel Teams July 26-29
- U11 (2011) and U12 (2010) Boys/Girls Travel Teams August 2-5
- U13 (2009) through U19 (2003) Boys/Girls Travel Teams August 9-12
- Elite Teams (2009-2003) Boys/Girls August 9-12



## **CASA SUMMER TRAVEL TEAMS**

CASA will be offering a Summer Travel program. We did not have a program in 2020 due to the pandemic but are looking to offer this again. We are still working on the details for the program, which primarily consists of the age groups that will be offered. More information should be available by the end of March.

- Roster of 16 minimum and 20 maximum for 2007 and older
- Roster of 12 minimum and 16 maximum for 2008 and younger
- All teams will be comprised of players from two calendar years; e.g. 2004 and 2005
- Program is expected to run from (approximately) from June 15 through August 2
- Train two times per week in the evenings, for an average of 12 14 sessions
- Coaches and Directors to place players on teams from pool of registered players in program
- Play in 3 tournaments (2 tournaments for younger teams)

# **World Cup Summer Camps**

This is a five week program that is designed to help push the development of each athlete to reach their maximum potential. The first four weeks will focus on technical abilities and the speed of the game. The goal is to encourage players to become calm on the ball and to have options before they receive the ball. The last week will be games. Teams will play for the World Cup trophy by playing in group stages, Round of 16, Quarterfinals, and the FINAL. This camp is designed for boys and girls age 7-16. The camps will be held at Ranger Fields at George Park. June 14<sup>th</sup> through July 16<sup>th</sup>



# **Goalkeeper and Striker Camp**

This is a positional camp for boys and girls aged 8-18. Camps will be conducted by our professional and experienced staff. The focus will be on improving the Individual Player in a camp environment. July  $19^{th}$  – July 22 from 6:00 – 8:00 pm.



### CASA/Harrisburg Heat Recreational Player Camp

This recreational camp will focus on improving players in the Recreational program with skill-building, game tactics, and match situations. Fun games, in a positive and nurturing environment, for boys and girls 5-14 years old. The dates for the camps have not been decided yet.
